A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Have you ever been told: “What you do screams so loudly, I cannot hear what you are saying.” **What words and actions in your life scream: “I believe Jesus is Lord”?**

As a Catholic community, **Stewardship is what we do after we say I believe. Stewardship is our challenge.**

Words cannot just mean whatever we want them to mean. That is a marvelous lesson taught in *Alice in Wonderland*. For the Christian, faith is an experience of God as He is revealed in Jesus Christ. It is personal. Theology is a reflection of that experience. Theology is “faith seeking understanding.” It begins to answer the question: “What did God reveal to me and how will this revelation direct my life? How will my actions magnify the Lord’s presence?” Belief is what we do after we say: **“Eureka!**

WOW! I am chosen to follow Jesus. I have the privilege of knowing something about God from God Himself!” Words and actions are very important - they reveal our beliefs.

We belong to Jesus. We are blessed. We have many gifts and talents; we can share Divine life. Baptized into Jesus, we are a new light, a new revelation of God. We are ordered to put the new light of God/Jesus on a lamp stand so others may see God. The followers of Jesus are those who are a city established on a hill, not tucked away on a quiet corner or hidden in a dark forest. The followers of Jesus are his very family. We are part of the Christ family! **As we belong to Jesus we are a “chosen race, a royal priesthood, a people set apart.”**

How we live shouts so loudly, we really don’t need to speak. That truth is attributed to St. Francis whose feast day is fast approaching on October 4th in his words: “Preach the Gospel, when necessary use words.” **We notice belief in action when we celebrate St. Vincent DePaul, feast September 27, as one who is noted for his works of charity. The St. Vincent De Paul society is alive in our parish. Might you be one with them in serving our neighbor in need?** We recognize the Gospel, preached without words, in the life of St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta.

Living the Gospel is the purpose of every Catholic parish community. **We exist only to imitate Jesus.** Moving the Gospel message from “a long time ago in a far-away-land” to right here and right now is our challenge, it’s our mission as a vibrant faith community. It’s what we do after we say: “I believe.” It’s stewardship.

How do you do the work of the Gospel by the way you live your life? Jesus himself came “not to be served but to serve.” Without a whole lot of noise or drama, but with faith, sacrifice, and joy, is there something more you can do to live the fullness of your baptismal grace?

Reflect on the gifts you have been given, your relationship of Jesus and his Church that you are part of, the secret of knowing who God is and what He is all about. **After you say: “I believe” what do you do to serve as Jesus served?** What can you do to celebrate your new life in Christ at St. Juliana Falconieri Catholic Community?

THANK YOU, TH ANK YOU, THANK YOU again THANK YOU to John and Maureen Kohaut - our Fall Festival Chair persons, all organization chair persons, all volunteers, and to everyone who came to the Fall Festival. Thank you if you invited a friend or neighbor who has never been to St. Juliana Fall Festival or to our parish community. The Fall Festival is the celebration of our community, it is one way we welcome our neighbors who might want to know who we are and what we are all about. **Thank you...when can we do this again?**

Here is stewardship in action: Rather than planning how many more people could come to the next Fall Festival, plan serving during the Fall Festival. Next year, I want YOU to be a Fall Festival volunteer and wear a Fall Festival volunteer shirt. You’ll do it because you believe **“Our mission is to be a welcoming family...”** (Mission Statement of St. Juliana Falconieri Parish). **It’s what we do after we say I believe. What you do screams so loudly...**

PENNIES FROM HEAVEN - REPORT

Congratulations! Wow! Wonderful! AND GOD BLESS YOU! As Fr. Mike says "St. Juliana's parishioners are the best and the most generous people." Of the 441 baby bottles that went out in August, 278 bottles were returned and the total of money that was collected was, \$7,689.88. \$148.48 was kept out to reimburse for the cost of 12 dozen extra baby bottles bought for hand-out. So the total of the check sent to the Diocese of Orange Office of Respect Life was, **\$7,541.40.
