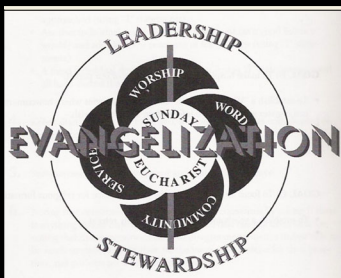

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Bad science works backwards. “I have a theory so I’ll manufacture all the evidence (data) I need to fit it.” It’s what most of us did for high school chemistry and physics to get a good grade. Knowing the conclusion, we worked backwards.

People of integrity know better than to fudge the facts and basically create a lie and believe it.

Today’s Gospel lesson begins: “Jesus said to his disciples: “If you love me, you will keep my commandments.” Stop right there.

Because I love my family and myself I do good and avoid evil. I don’t want bad press against me or my family name. Right? Doesn’t the moral life, like all things, revolve around me?

Because I love my family and myself, I will not cheat, I will not create a ruckus. I make the right decision simply so I can live with myself.

Obedying the moral law “for the love of God” is a high standard. Jesus’ command will have purpose only if you allow it to take root in your life. Christianity or any religious behavior is added to the “human condition” — it is an addition layered placed on top of being human. Christian moral decision making says: “I do what I do as a Divine Command.” I love God, I wish to imitate Jesus, and I have discerned right action with the guidance of the Holy Spirit. It is with courage and understanding of God’s will that I have chosen the right choice and I will do it.

Choosing the right act because we love Jesus is a lot different from doing it because I simply want to live comfortably in my own skin. The end of self-centered narcissism is the beginning of a life of sacrifice and an orientation toward Jesus.

Listening to the promptings of the advocate, the Holy Spirit, the one who pleads for us on our behalf before doing anything is what eighty-five young men and women of our parish community have learned to do. These eighty-five received the Sacrament of Confirmation last Thursday night. Sealed with courage to be solid Catholic Christians in decision making, good judgement, awe and wonder of the presence of God, and understanding of God’s will, young men and women of our parish will be make a difference.

Help them to remain strong in Christ and the Holy Spirit.

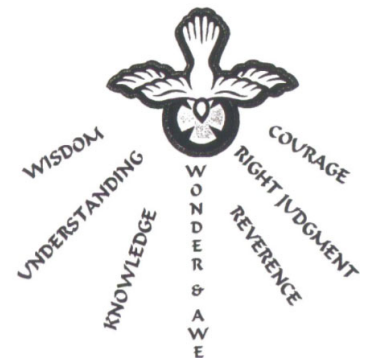
We Catholics were never meant to be just ordinary people. Jesus said, "I come that you may have life, and have it more abundantly." That superabundance of life comes to us every day through the Holy Spirit.

Find some time of solitude each week - hopefully every day to walk away from schedules and deadlines and the misconception you have to be in control. Find an empty place within yourselves and invite the Spirit in. The Spirit will not enter uninvited. He’s right here in our church all the time. Make time for a visit. Come to daily Mass.

Psst! There is data to show what Jesus and the Holy Spirit can do to make your life super-ordinary. Look at the great ones; Albert Schweitzer, Mother Teresa, Nelson Mandela, Peter Maurin, Dorothy Day, Thomas Merton, members of our parish, and every saint. All of them found the “Treasure of Great Price” when they quit looking at themselves. They could have been “sort of Christians” but they went all out, full throttle. Throwing off the ordinary and scarcity, they found abundance.

Love Jesus and keep his command to serve others as he has served you. Do it with Confirmation courage.

Congratulations to our 2017 Confirmation Class, their sponsors, and each member of the Confirmation preparation team. Have the courage to continue living your life as Catholic Christians. Live as authentic Catholics, men and women of integrity. Make time for prayer and friendship with the Lord. Now, newly sealed with the Holy Spirit, be inspiring to all of us. Show us the way to love Jesus and keep his commands – ALWAYS! Become the saint you chose. God Bless You!

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS - DID YOU KNOW THIS?

The custom of genuflection is not found everywhere in the Catholic Church. In fact, it is a bit of breach of etiquette to genuflect in most Eastern Catholic Churches. If you're visiting an Eastern Catholic or an Orthodox church, the "when in Rome" rule should be adopted. Watch what the home team is doing! Usually, Eastern Catholics and Orthodox reserve a small portion of the eucharistic bread for the dying in a cupboard or eucharistic dove, but it is not a center of attention or devotion. The rule is to make a profound bow, called a "metasis," toward the altar—bowing deeply while making the sign of the cross.

East and West split years before we Westerners began to reserve the Blessed Sacrament prominently in our churches. Thus, the East never changed the original custom of bowing toward the altar. Increasingly, as tabernacles became more widespread in the West and moved into prominent placement within churches, we replaced the bow toward the altar with a genuflection toward the Blessed Sacrament when its place of reservation is visible.

In a church where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved in a special chapel or off the main axis of the building, normally you should bow toward the altar when you enter your pew, because the eucharistic table is the principal sign of Christ's presence in the church building. If you have ever participated in the liturgy of Dedication of a Church and Altar, there is no mistaking the altar's significance: it is first slathered with chrism and then adorned with a brazier billowing clouds of incense that fill the whole church as a sign of prayer and presence!
