


#### THE PARISH AS ONE BODY

#### A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

I really like what the Feast of Pentecost means. There's certainly an unabashed fierceness about it. That is what is captured symbolically only in furious wind and fire. It's a wildness that is difficult to find in today's older Church, which is so tactful, so domesticated, so worried about what the neighbors might think.

Then there are the younger members of our faith community and Cal State University Fullerton who are Catholics boldly. They wear their crosses on the outside of their shirts, they make time to visit the Holy Eucharist in our church, they are concerned about knowing, feeling, and acting as Catholics should. They were recently confirmed. They recently returned to "the Lord and Giver of Life." They want to read the Bible with understanding, pray with

the heart, and lead moral lives that are pleasing to God. They want to be Catholic fiercely. They want to be known.

It's the millennials that I am most concerned about. They are the ones who, if they don't catch the gifts of the Holy Spirit NOW, most likely won't. At least that's what the research and writings explain to all who will read them.

Yes, I am energized when I meet our younger members who are boldly, militantly if you will, Catholic. It's clear from all the results of Pentecost that the Spirit ignites their souls. They have been called from passivity, to new life.

The Spirit is not calling the faithful to be fragile. Review the recent life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. She looked as fragile as an eggshell yet trying to stop her was no different from trying to stop a runaway train. Read the story of Dorothy Day who was courageous in the practice of the faith in a large city. Whose Christian life captures you interest? Recall Helen Reddy, she might not have been singing as a Christian, when she belted out fearlessly "I am woman! Hear me ROAR!" Could you say the same about your faith: "I am a Catholic Christian, hear me ROAR!"

What about our faith causes you to ROAR? What in our faith gives you life? How do the neighbors, business associates, or fellow students know that the Holy Spirit is the source of your life?

Of all of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, pray for understanding. The understanding to know what God wants you to do. Pray for courage. The courage to be bold in the practice of the faith. Pray for a good sense of Awe and Wonder of God and His presence in your life.

The Holy Spirit wants to do nothing more than animate the life of the Body of Christ the whole Church today.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your Faithful. Kindle in us the fire of Your love. Grant that, instructed by your light, we may be truly wise and forever rejoice in your Truth.



#### PENTECOST SUNDAY

The Catechism of the Catholic Church sees Pentecost as the principal Scriptural foundation for the sacrament of Confirmation:

"On several occasions Christ promised this outpouring of the Spirit, a promise which he fulfilled first on Easter Sunday [by breathing upon the Apostles] and then more strikingly at Pentecost." (CCC 1287)

The connection between Confirmation and Pentecost is so strong, that the Roman Catechism of the Council of Trent desired that the sacrament "be administered principally at Pentecost", explaining that "on that day especially were the Apostles strengthened and confirmed by the power of the Holy Ghost."

St. Thomas Aquinas summarizes this tradition well:

"In this sacrament [Confirmation], the Holy Ghost is given to the baptized for strength: just as he was given to the apostles on the day of Pentecost." (ST III, q.72, a.7)

#### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

Today, the languages of the whole world arise to God in a Pentecost of praise. In some American dioceses, the Mass is offered every Sunday in more than thirty different languages, including the silent praise of American Sign Language. Fifty years ago, the landscape of liturgy was very different. It was grounded firmly in Latin, which is to the present day still the official language of the Roman Rite. Very few people were fluent in Latin, even though in those days Latin was far more widely studied in school. Nevertheless, almost every Catholic was competent in the responses and chants of Latin since it is not difficult to pronounce. The clergy were normally minimally competent in Latin, since much of seminary education was conducted in that language.

When the Second Vatican Council was convened, all of the debate and daily work of the council was to be in Latin. In the first session in 1962, Boston's Cardinal Richard Cushing continually complained about it, and threatened not to return in 1963 if something wasn't done. He convinced the fathers when he rose to speak in fairly fluent Latin in an unforgettable Boston twang. The next year, he returned, but with a simultaneous translation system funded by the people of Boston. The ordinary everyday language of the people, the vernacular, had arrived at the Vatican via Boston!


