


THE PARISH AS ONE BODY

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The Parables of the Wheat and the Weeds, The Scattered Seed, the Mustard Seed, the Leaven, the Buried Treasure and the Pearl of Great Price have been proclaimed on various Sundays and daily Masses several times in the past couple of weeks. I hope they have been significant in your reflection and personal conversion. Perhaps even table conversation.

These parables call us to initial and on-going conversion. They are about the way God's love comes into our life and grows - or not. They are also about God's People, The Church, how the faith community directs all people toward God – or not.

The parables teach that some people catch the Word of God as they latch on to a relationship of pure love. It is found, rejoiced over, and grows as love does; serving people's needs. This

conversion of behavior is the Christian social order, the Reign of the Kingdom of God. Other people catch the Word of God as they do a new iPhone. It's novel. They are initially quite happy. Their happiness lasts until the next model is developed. Never completely satisfied with what they have, they are slaves, forever chasing technology because "Well, everyone's doing it. If I don't have the latest, I'm left out."

The new social order of God's Kingdom brings about liberation from oppressive forces. It brings about "good news" for the poor and all who are marginalized. God's Kingdom is a New Creation!

The parables mentioned have to do with growth, the gradual development of God's love taking hold of individuals and changing them into a community which is God's community, His Kingdom. It's the call to conversion, discipleship, and maturity to apostleship.

The parable of leaven demonstrates the production of an awful lot of bread. Like the wedding feast of Cana the result is abundance, specifically it is the abundance of God's love. When it is mixed with flower, leaven brings about a change. The leaven is God's reign which is expected to bring a huge change in humankind. Followers of Jesus are expected to grow, full of new life, as the flour does. The fellow who sowed the good seeds expected an extra-large crop. He scattered in abundance, extravagantly, and carelessly. You would expect the farmer to sow in neatly plowed rows. This guy threw seeds, which cost money, everywhere. And he expected the seeds to flower. An unexpected found treasure will bring about a life altering change, so would the great pearl. Why do you play the lottery?

What will transform us from individuals to a community? Then to a community united by the Holy Eucharist? What will enable us to grow in understanding Jesus' Kingdom? Faith. Faith, an experience of Jesus and a relationship with him. Today's Gospel lesson, Peter walking on water, makes the point. He grows through his conversion, which began with a call by Jesus. He gave up everything and went from a fisherman to a disciple, one who was taught by Jesus in a community of faith. He was converted from a former way of life to a new person who confessed faith/belief in Jesus: "Who do you say that I am?" Askes Jesus. "You are the Christ" Peter responds. Today's Gospel informs us that when faith is fragile, life is quite turbulent. But, when faith is strong we can walk on water.

A change of life is at work in us who experience a relationship with Jesus. Conversion, an orientation of life to the mystery of God alive is alive in us. It begins small and grows. It happens whenever we recognize we are encountering Jesus as we do in the sacraments, as we do in ordinary prayer, and in the study of our faith. It is profoundly present when we rejoice in the find and say "I Praise you, Jesus!"

Rejoice in your growth toward God's Kingdom. Be the presence of God where ever you go. You need not be a loud and obvious earthquake. A refreshing sound, a whisper, a soft breeze will do. (See today's first reading.) Give someone encouragement today: "The Lord Be With You!"





NOTHING TO FEAR

A rabbi was asked why God sends trials and troubles into human lives. "Because God gets lonely for his people" was the reply. There is some resonance with this wisdom in today's Gospel, as Jesus makes his disciples get into a boat without him and goes off alone while they venture into stormy waters. Of course, neither Jews nor Christians believe that the Almighty plays this sort of whimsical game with them, but there is some truth in the statement that we don't turn to God for saving help until we're in a bind. Peter's role today, as it is throughout the New Testament, is to be a sign or to represent each member of the church and the whole church. Our story is the tale told about Peter's faith today. What can bolster our faith is that even when Christ calls us to face bravely the tempests of life, if we are walking through them with our eyes fixed on him in faith, we have nothing to fear. Even when we falter or sink, simply crying "Lord, save me!" is enough to help us know the steady grasp of God's hand. Then, sheltered inside the walls of faith, the storms we

endure lose their power over us.
