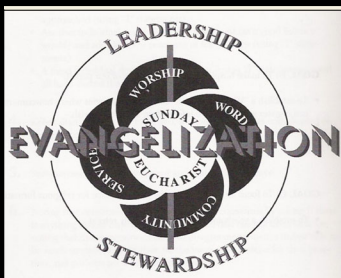

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The Feast of the Transfiguration is celebrated every year on August 6th. It is a feast of Our Lord and has the special privilege of interrupting the ordinary Sunday cycle of readings and prayers, when August 6th is a Sunday. August 6 was chosen for this celebration because it was on August 6, 1456 that news of the Crusaders defeating the Turks at Belgrade reached Rome. Pope Callistus III placed this feast on the calendar to commemorate a battle won. Our Lady of Victory, now known as Our Lady of the Rosary (The feast of Rosary Academy), celebrated on October 7 has a similar distinction. Isn't this just riveting? The Transfiguration scene in St. Mark's Gospel is proclaimed on the Second Sunday of Lent year B. The Transfiguration is one of twelve significant feasts in the Orthodox calendar. Pope St. John Paul II named it one of the five Luminous Mysteries. Some scholars believe the teaching to be a misplaced Easter narrative. Humm

The Transfiguration scene is in each of the three synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke). It's important! Something significant happened. Divinity was revealed to the disciples in an extra-ordinary way. Their lives were changed. Allow your life to be changed too!

Take time and read the passage again during the week. (Do not take the **Journeysongs** book home. If you have a **Journeysongs** book in your private possession, please return it, no need for confession!) Read the passage s-l-o-w-l-y. Or have someone read it aloud to you or a group or your family. Listen for important words, directions, where does it take place, what is happening, to whom, emotions, and why are Moses and Elijah mentioned?

Google TRANSFIGURATION on the menu click **images**. There are some rather good images even line drawings of the Transfiguration. Some silly looking ones as well. Click the option **stained glass**, some magnificent images will be found there. Art often reveals scenes of faith, allow these scenes to "do their thing" for you.

Reflect on just one person in the lesson. Perhaps Peter. Jesus is giving the three disciples a special gift; insight to himself. Peter is special in the group. He receives the gift best. He becomes bright, radiant with joy and intellectual insight. Peter is usually full of life. Peter follows Jesus' command to fish where he is told, to walk on water, and etc. Peter is also the one who realizes the need for Jesus; he confesses belief that Jesus is the Christ, and he realizes that he is a sinful person. Peter is captivated by Jesus. In this lesson, Peter sees Jesus in a new way, a way that goes beyond any ordinary form that Jesus had previously. Peter is now able to see the divinity of Jesus.

Like an epiphany, a transfiguration moment is a split moment when "the light goes on" and Jesus is clarified. It's an "aha" moment. "Now I get it!" All previous encounters are set aside. This one stands out because it goes beyond the rest. It's not just a confession of faith: "You are the Christ." In this recognition of faith, Peter encounters Jesus in a new way. He sees beyond Jesus' humanity. It's a life changing encounter with the Lord. Pssst: they all are!

And in that encounter all Peter can do is to say: "Lord, it's good that we are here."

Lastly, reflect on my favorite piece of American Poetry: "The Battle Hymn of the Republic". We don't use the term "transfigure" very often. Here it is used in a powerful way: "In the beauty of the lilies Christ was born across the sea, with a glory in his bosom that transfigures you and me; As he died to make us holy, let us die that all be free! While God is marching on."

Reflect on how God has changed your life. It might be in very simple way: being grateful for what you have and not complaining about what is missing or helping instead of waiting to be served. Share a significant faith story with your family. That time when you were certain God was with you. Maybe just setting aside a moment for prayer in your life when you could be

Wow! Awesome! Eureka! Interrupted by God our life is holy, we are radiant with joy. Contagious joy! How good it is that we are the Catholic faith community of St. Juliana Falconieri!
