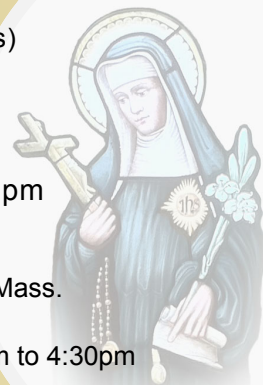

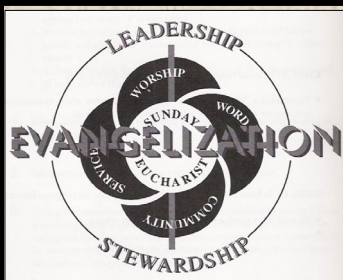

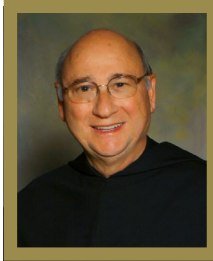

Congratulations to our children on the occasion of their *First Holy Communion* this Saturday. My special thanks to our parents and teachers for preparing the children. This moment in the faith-life of our children is so exciting for our little ones. Since the first day they learned about Jesus and the basics of Eucharistic theology, they watched the adult faith community walk up to the altar to receive the Eucharistic Jesus. They crossed their arms and received a blessing. Now they will be able to walk to the altar not as spectators but finally as participants. They will look up to their parents and all around them to feel a part of the believing and professing church. Our little ones need us to continue to train them to love and celebrate with them this great gift of the Holy Eucharist.

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church we read these words foundational to our belief as Catholics and which we share with other Christians: *"The holy Eucharist completes Christian initiation...At the Last Supper, on the night he was betrayed, our Savior instituted the Eucharistic sacrifice of his Body and Blood. This he did in order to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until he should come again, and so to entrust to his beloved Spouse, the Church, a memorial of his death and resurrection: a sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a bond of charity, a Paschal banquet 'in which Christ is consumed, the mind is filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.'"*

For the past five or six months our Knights of Columbus have been busy with the planning and execution of the new Our Lady of Grace Grotto on the east side of the church. The Grotto is beautiful and a fitting tribute to our blessed Mother, Mary. This Sunday following the 9am Mass, we will dedicate the Grotto. My prayer is that we will visit the Grotto, say a prayer, and ask for a blessing as we walk about the neighborhood or come early to morning and Sunday Masses. I extend my thanks to the Knights and benefactors who contributed to this project.

Confirmation with Bishop Dominic Luong next Saturday, May 11th at 10am in church initiates our High School Youth Ministry second year confirmation class into spiritual adulthood. In the Catechism of the Catholic Church we read the following sentences which help explain the steps involved in conferring of the Holy Spirit: *"Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the 'sacraments of Christian initiation,' whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For 'by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed'.... Preparation for Confirmation should aim at leading the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a more lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit--his actions, his gifts, and responsibilities of Christian life."*

I am sure you have heard the phrase: *The New Evangelization*. Evangelization is the process whereby we share the good news

and truth of the gospel with others especially those who have not heard of Jesus or the Church. Evangelization is part of the missionary work of the church. By means of teaching and example, the faithful reach out to those who are un-churched, that is, those who have no affiliation with a faith community and have not been instructed in basic Christian teaching.

While *Evangelization* is a relatively new word in our Catholic lexicon, the idea of sharing and spreading the Gospel is as old as the New Testament. The Acts of the Apostles is the book of *Evangelization* because it records the earliest preaching of the Apostles and early church believers.

The word "New" is new to evangelization since it refers to evangelizing the "evangelized." Those who have heard the good news, received baptism, and profess the Christian faith, have been evangelized but for any number of reasons have drifted away or lost their dynamism. These brothers and sisters need to rehear the truth of the gospel in a new and more convincing way, evangelized anew, and invited to return to the practice of their Catholic Faith.

A new book written by Catholic author and motivational speaker, Matthew Kelly, entitled: *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic* reaches out to Catholics who need to be re-engaged. He shares the result of years of research with the reader by describing *The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic*. The first sign is: **Prayer**. Dynamic Catholics have a daily commitment to prayer. God is not a distant force to these people, but rather a personal friend and adviser. They are trying to listen to the voice of God in their lives, and believe doing God's will is the only path that leads to lasting happiness in this changing world (and beyond). The second sign is: **Study**. Dynamic Catholics are continuous learners. On average Dynamic Catholics spend fourteen minutes each day learning more about the faith. They see themselves as students of Jesus and his church, and proactively make an effort to allow his teachings to form them. The third sign is: **Generosity**. Dynamic Catholics are generous. Dynamic Catholics are filled with a spirit of service and are generous stewards of their time, talent and treasure. They see generosity as the heart of Christianity and the proof that the teachings of Christ have taken root in their lives. Generosity is not a religious requirement for them; it's a way of life, a way of bringing the love of God to the world. The fourth sign is: **Evangelization**. Dynamic Catholics invite others to grow spiritually by sharing the love of God with them. Having seen how a vibrant spiritual life has transformed them and every aspect of their lives, highly engaged Catholics want others to experience the joy that flows from having a dynamic relationship with God. Though they don't consider themselves to be actively evangelizing, they are constantly trying to help people develop vibrant spiritual lives by discovering the genius and beauty of Catholicism.

In the days ahead you will hear about the long-range plan for our parish to utilize this book and an earlier one from Matthew Kelly entitled, *Rediscovering Catholicism*.
