



Now you are Christ's body, and individually parts of it. " (1 cor. 12:17-25)



A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

November 25, 2018



Thanksgiving Weekend! There's no other secular holiday that can be rewardingly holy. It's made holy when we are filled with thanks. Giving thanks is rewarding both for the giver and the receiver. Right?

This weekend I give thanks to our parish school. Sometimes we might by cynical — "Ho, hum, what's the use? What really are the kids learning? How will we ever know they learned the **religious** lessons of the school?" To be a recognized school their test scores have to be in a certain percentage level for some years, they have to have so many minutes of curriculum, and so many classes and learning experiences during the day. To be a religious school, faith has to be taught. More important than teaching is practicing the learning, including the faith. The Catholic school will be successful when its graduates imitate Jesus. To imitate Jesus they have to know him and grow in a relationship with him.

Some pastors don't fancy the parish school. Our parish would be boring without it. And the school would be boring without good homilies. That's where I come in! (HAHAHAHAA)

Not long ago I had morning Mass with several classes. The first reading and the Gospel each spoke about life; life coming from the preaching of St. Paul and life flowing from the temple into the city and its environs. Typically, I begin the homily with some everyday experience and nonsense - hopefully to engage the students. That day it was: breakfast cereal. "Ja ever notice how life-less Corn Flakes are? They just mostly get soggy. They don't **do** anything. Can any of you tell me an improvement on Corn Flakes?" Hands go up. "Coco-Puffs! They make the milk turn to chocolate." Good, they are playing the game, I continue. "Rice Krispies, they talk! Snap, Crackle, and Pop!" "Lucky Charms, they are filled with colors." Fine, I've got them. Can we think of something else? I continue my plan. "How about at church, right here; is there something that has no life until life is given to it?" Right away, as fast as Maury Wills could steal second base a hand goes up. "Yes?" I've got you. "The bread turns into the Eucharist and the wine turns into the Blood of Jesus" the student snaps and is satisfied with his answer.


Yes! Bravo! Thank You! I give thanks to the administrators, teachers, aides, whole faculty and staff of our school for having taught the **religious** lessons so well. I also thank all parents who reinforce Catholic education in your homes and weekly and Sunday Mass. Really, it makes my day and our community.

If you can come, be present with the school students at daily Mass. Kindergarten, first, and second grades on Tuesday at 8:00AM. Third, fourth, and fifth grades on Wednesday at 8:00AM. Sixth, seventh and eighth grades on Friday at 8:00AM.







Jean M. Twenge, Professor of Psychology at San Diego State University, is the author of more than 140 scientific publications and books.

Dr. Twenge frequently gives talks and seminars on teaching and working with today's young generation based on a dataset of 11 million young people. Her audiences have included college faculty and staff, high school teachers, military personnel, camp directors, and corporate executives. Her research has been covered in Time, Newsweek, The New York Times, USA Today, U.S. News and World Report, and The Washington Post, and she has been featured on Today, Good Morning America, CBS This Morning, Fox and Friends, NBC Nightly News, Dateline NBC, and National Public Radio.

She holds a BA and MA from the University of Chicago and a Ph.D. from the University of Michigan. She lives in San Diego with her husband and three daughters.


