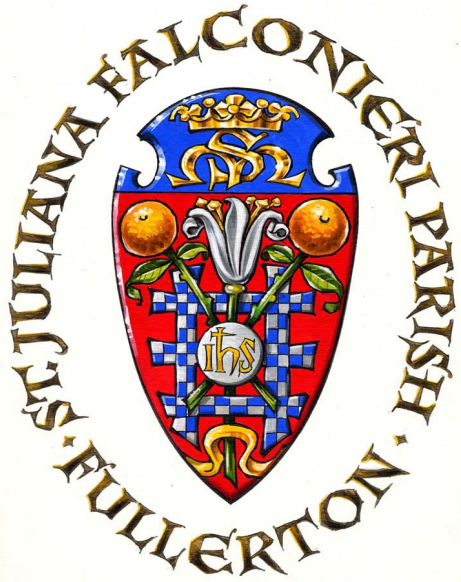

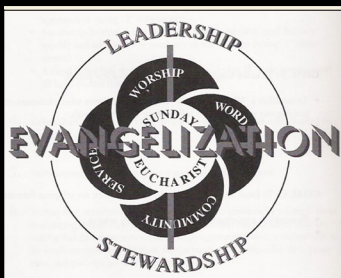
MARRIAGE ~ Couples planning to be married should contact a Priest or a Deacon at least six months before scheduling a date for their wedding.

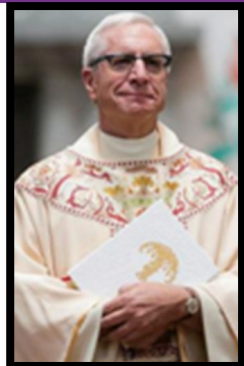

I've involved you with the study of twins - **compassion and empathy** who help us to reach out and connect with other people, to have emotional feelings for, identification with, and proper understanding of what other people are experiencing. These are feelings of the heart for all people, our neighbor, sibling, spouse, or those yet unknown to us. The compassion and empathy twins risk being "there for" other people, performing acts of kindness that the narcissist, whose interest is the self alone, cannot do.



I introduced you to **honesty and trust**. Truth is their parent. This pair of twins enable us to speak truth without which our communication with each other and society, whether it be a country, classroom, business office, or classroom would fall apart. Their cousin is charity. These direct us in proper ways of "handling the truth" so that we won't be cruel or hoodwinked and have to live with paranoia.

Today, meet more twins: **unity and peace**. Unity and peace are the "will of our Heavenly Father." They are the way in which God wants us to live. When we pray "thy will be done" I firmly believe that God's will is that nobody be lost. That's unity. There are too many indicators of this truth. Consider the Lost Sheep, the Lost Boy (Prodigal Son), Zacchaeus, The Garden before the Fall, or John 17:21. It's just so obvious that from the beginning Almighty God desired unity. Add peace, and you have more of the way God intended us to live. Not peace, the absence of war or conflict like no arguing around the Thanksgiving table, rather peace meaning "*Shalom*" the fullness of life. *Shalom* is life free from anxiety or distress, enabling one's life to be devoted to God and not distractions from God. One can't be orientated toward God if he/she is focused on distress or other stressors. Ask good Tevye from "*Fiddler on the Roof*" – he longed for *shalom* during the entire drama.

It's also what we, the People of God, of the Church long for. Pray these prayers carefully: "**by the help of your mercy, (Oh, God) we may be always free from sin and safe from all distress.**" Sin and distress distract us from our purpose of serving God in this world so we will be happy with Him in the next. And this gem: "**Peace I leave you, my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will.**" Those two prayers are prayed between the Our Father and the sign of peace at every Mass. Pray them with purpose. Practice the purpose of the prayer.

Pray that Jesus bestow peace and unity on us and people of every tribe and nation, culture, tongue, and inclination. May our hearts and lives be turned toward the unity and peace desired for us by God. May we receive that for which we pray!

As we begin Advent, let us all once again prepare ourselves for the gifts of Christ.

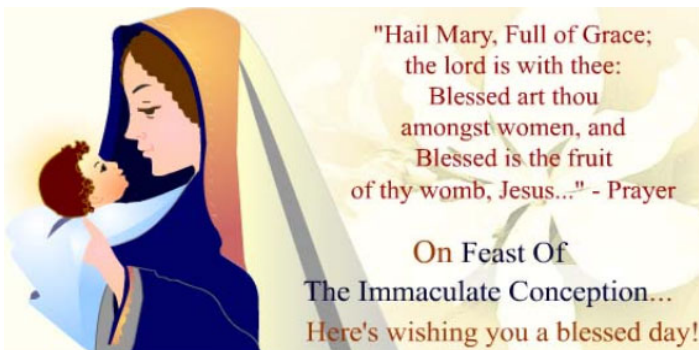

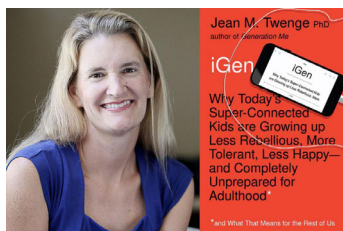
More about Prof. Twenge

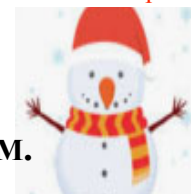

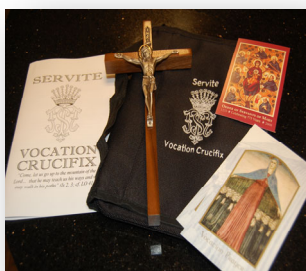
