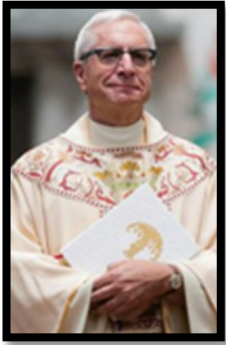

## Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

The word “gospel” means “**good news.**” A lot of people proclaim good news. A politician does it like this: “Have I got good news for you! The stock market is up – un-employment is down. Houses are affordable, the streets and our schools are safe!”

The baseball fanatic proclaims good news: “Take me out to the ball game! It’s time for baseball – Angels, Dodgers, Cubs, Yankees – your favorite team and mine. Pop-corn! Peanuts! Red-hot dogs. No ketchup of course.

This Easter Sunday in this Year of Faith we gather together and celebrate the Good News of our faith. Today we hear that great hymn of good news: **ALLELUIA! HE IS RISEN!**

Today, this Easter morning you have made a decision – love is a decision – you have made a decision to love the Lord and his community once again. You have made a decision to imitate the first disciples and hurry from your beds. You made a decision to seek Jesus. Today, this Easter morning in faith you proclaim what is most joyful to you, that oldest and most important hymn of Christianity –**ALLELUIA! HE IS RISEN!**

On this Easter morning, faithfully believe what you hear and imitate what you believe. Renew your faith. Live your faith. This IS your faith, this is the faith of your Church, this is the day of the resurrection.

Psst - I’ve got some good news to tell you: “Jesus Christ is Risen Today!” Believe it and live it fully.

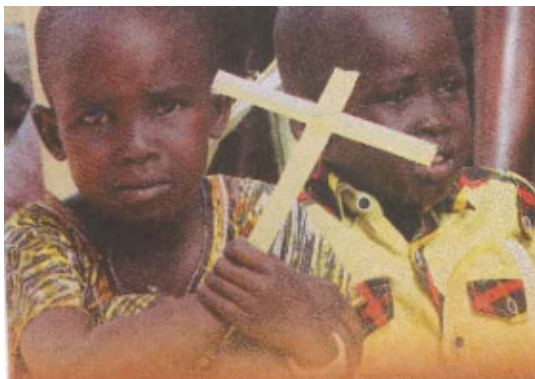

## TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

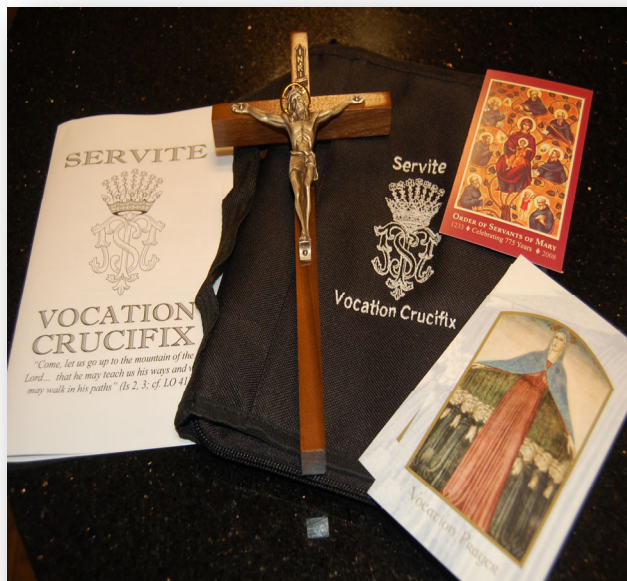
The Paschal Mystery is the key to our Christian faith: the dying and rising of Jesus that is the pattern of our life. In their first steps on the road of faith, the catechumens feel the cross of glory traced over their eyes, on their lips, across their shoulders, on their ears, over their heart, and on their feet. The mystery is that even death gives way to life for those who are held in the embrace of Jesus. Today, many new Christians arise from the waters of the font. Yet the font is not the destination of their journey. The goal is Pentecost, fifty days from now, and a lifetime of praise to the Father, in Christ, in the embrace of the Holy Spirit, for the sake of the world. "Neophyte," our ancient word for newly-baptized people, means "newly-planted" in Greek. If someone in your parish has just been baptized, welcome them today. The smiles on their faces and the light in the eyes is a foretaste of heaven.

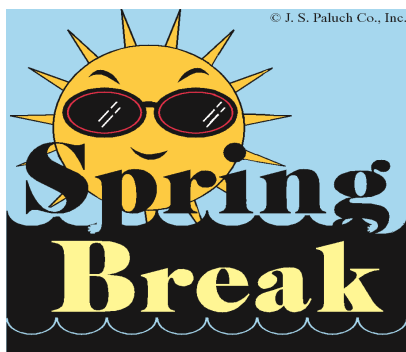
School tours will take place at 9:00am each Tuesday morning.

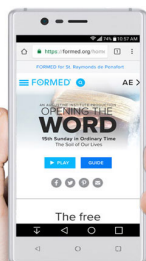
