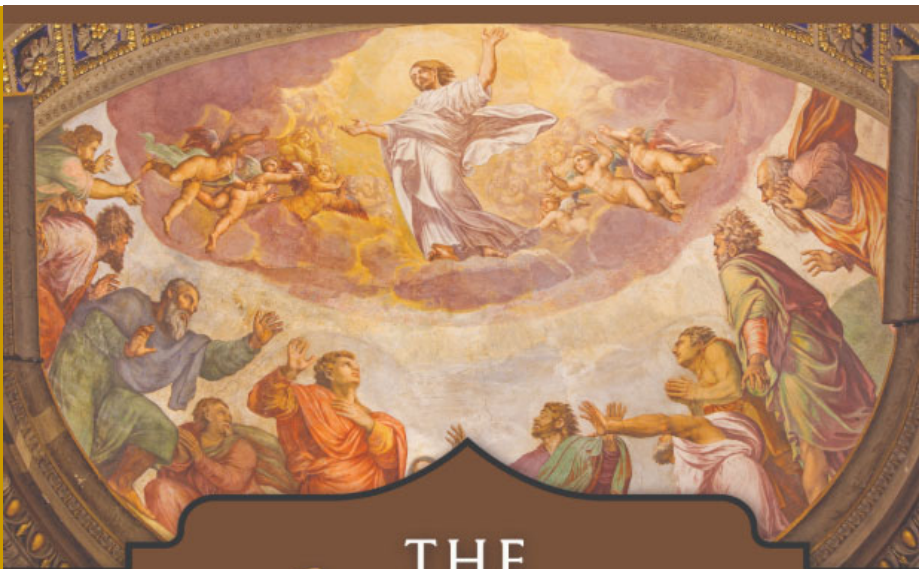

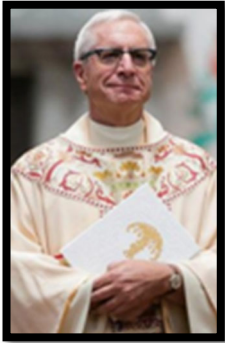

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Some don't know the past, for them it's always been this way. Others remember there has been a change.

On February 12 we celebrated the birthday of Abraham Lincoln the sixteenth President of the United States. On February 22 we celebrated the birthday of George Washington our country's first President. They were national holidays. There has been a change to one national "Presidents Day." And there seems to be national grammar confusion if it is a plural or possessive plural noun - Presidents or Presidents' Day. UGH.

Used to be Roman Catholic holydays were holydays with the obligation to attend Mass and were kept without being switched or suppressed. AND THERE WAS NO CATHOLIC SCHOOL, the holyday was a school holiday! Forty days after Easter is a Thursday, the Thursday of the Ascension of the Lord into Heaven. Today there is a change! In the United States, the Dioceses of Boston, Hartford, New York, Omaha, and Philadelphia have retained the Ascension on Thursday; all the others have transferred the Solemnity to the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Meaning for us the 7th Sunday of Eastertime is eliminated.

Other days cannot change and will not be eliminated! Mother's Day is always the second Sunday of May! Mom demands stability. Can you imagine a year without Mother's Day?

We rise on Mother's Day, put on good clothing, we use our best manners to celebrate Mom. Literally, we rise to a genteel, a classy way of living with and for Mom. It's an ascension.

What is it about Mom? She's the one who gives life. She's the one who forms family members to become the best people we were made to be. Sometimes it's with "tough love" other times a gentle spirit. Mom encourages family traditions. By keeping the traditions, the family knows who it is and what it is about. "My Mom says" is as good as any creed. Ascension Sunday and Mother's Day Sunday just go together, don't they?

Young members of our parish – you recently experienced new life in our faith community. You received Holy Eucharist for the first time. Teens, you were recently "sealed with the Holy Spirit" in the Sacrament of Confirmation. We celebrate your courage to journey farther in your faith, in your knowledge, experience, and relationship with God. Become proud members of the Catholic faith community and remain members wherever you are. Don't ever forget: "God loves you and is watching over you." Like a good Mom, that should both encourage and direct you to live your life fully.

The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is not about the Lord going up and out of sight and mind like a rocket into distant space. It's about the courage of the apostles to rise to life in its fullness. It's about the apostles and the way they preached Jesus and lived his message as they were taught and experienced it. They kept the tradition and passed it on to – well, us! Through the apostles, the word of Jesus went out to those who did not know it YET. It has reached us!

Today as you rise to celebrate Mom, rise to celebrate Jesus and his word. Rise to celebrate your courage to live Jesus' message wherever you are. As a family reflects its Mom, so must the Christian reflect our Christ.

Some things never change. It's the ascension to life in its fullness we celebrate.

Happy Feast of the Ascension. Happy Mother's Day.

In today's scriptures we hear two different stories about commissioning. In the Acts of the Apostles Peter leads the assembly in prayer that the Lord will choose and commission the person to replace Judas among the Twelve. 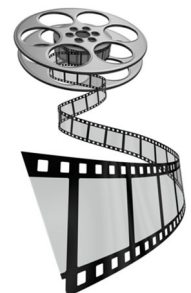

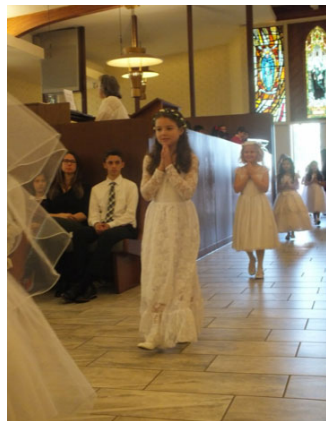

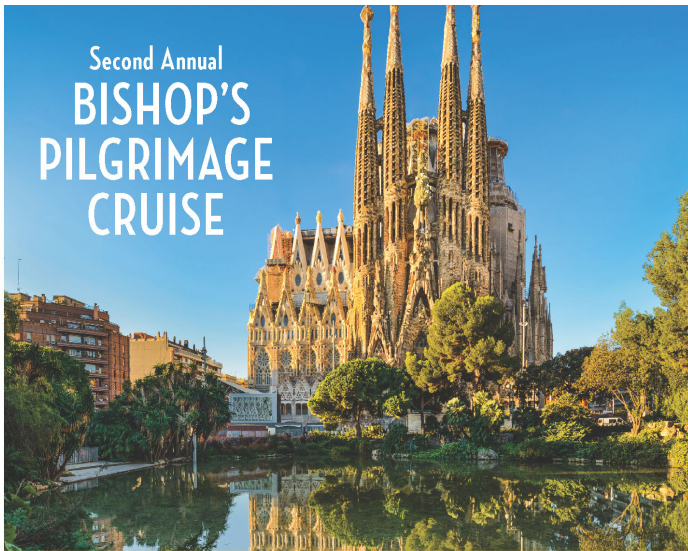
