


## THE PARISH AS ONE BODY

## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The Church season has returned to "Ordinary Time" once more. We had some weeks of "Ordinary Time" between the conclusion of the Christmas Season until Ash Wednesday, now until the Feast of Christ the King, it's "Ordinary Time." Some of you might recall that before the 1970 Liturgical Renewal, this season was marked by the "Sundays After Pentecost." I wonder if there is a difference.

Pentecost says: "Go forth! Do something holy. Live your life for God! Renew the face of the Earth!"

HO, HUM - Ordinary Time is missing a verb. Ordinary Time lacks activity. Yawn, b-o-r-i-n-g!

I like what Pentecost says: GO! BE a missionary disciple, renew, set a fire. I want us, the parish of St. Juliana Falconieri, to be that force. Where ever you are, be it in school, a playground, the office, shopping, at the stadium, airport, on the internet, etc. you are a Christian, you are a member of the Roman Catholic Church, you are part of the Christ Family. St. Juliana is your address. How would anyone know?

We, the baptized, we who receive Holy Communion, and are Confirmed—Sealed with the Holy Spirit—we participate in the mission of Christ and his mission of proclaiming the Good News of the Kingdom of God. We go forth from Mass and proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom of God by the way we live our lives. Where-ever you are!

If practicing Christianity was a criminal offense; would you be convicted?

To practice our faith effectively, allow the gifts of the Holy Spirit especially the gifts of knowledge and courage to be yours and ours as the St. Juliana Community. Know our faith profoundly and live it courageously in the community as she did (our patroness, St. Juliana). If it doesn't happen at and around the church community, where will Christianity stand a chance?

But Juliana is a saint! Psst – the life of a saint is your life too!

I encourage you to take part, as best you can, in the faith formation opportunities of our parish and its Catholic grammar school. Take part, as best your own calendar allows you, to participate in the various worship services of our faith community, especially First Tuesday Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Consider daily Mass, not just during Lent, but during "Ordinary Time." We are more than Mass on Sunday, and a grammar school from August to June. Catholicism is more than a Lent thing or Easter duty.

Be part of the community of St. Juliana Falconieri Parish. This is your faith community seven days a week.

During this season after Pentecost, do more than what is ordinary.

Be excited about the gift of faith you have received. Do not give up the mood or attitude of Pentecost. Give your faith life, and your life faith.

If you can serve the community in any way, I encourage you to do so. If you need to be served, ask how we can help you. St. Juliana Parish is no "ordinary place." Endowed with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit of God's Love, we

come here and go from here to live our faith courageously.

Be on your GUARD; STAND FIRM in the faith; be COURAGEOUS; be STRONG. Do everything in LOVE.
