


THE PARISH AS ONE BODY

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

St. Francis Albert Sinatra sang: "Take All Of Me". St. Ignatius Loyola taught the simple *suscipe* (Latin for take) prayer: "Take, Lord, and receive all my liberty, my memory, my understanding, and my entire will, all that I have and possess. Thou hast given all to me. To Thee, O Lord, I return it. All is Thine, dispose of it wholly according to Thy will. Give me Thy love and Thy grace, for this is sufficient for me." (Ignatius Loyola). Perhaps you have sung it in the song: "Take Lord, Receive" by the St. Louis Jesuits.

Discipleship is giving God what He deserves. It's being part of God's family: Doing the will of God, allowing God to receive us, makes us part of His household.

What is it that God wants of us? He wants the crown of His creation, us, to be "fully human and fully alive." Isn't that obvious as we begin summer in Southern California? To be fully human, fully alive, we must "know, love, and serve God in this world so that we will be happy with Him in the next." The sayings might be old, but that doesn't mean they are no longer true or effective.

It's the way we share our goods. Love is the way we give what we receive.

It's putting ourselves at God's disposal.

Take time during the summer to put yourself on a retreat. Spend time before you leave home or when you return to just find a way to get to a "happy spot" and seek union with the Lord who might be missing in your busy everyday life. Enjoy what Southern California offers in its splendor and of its natural beauty. Bring a Bible, your rosary, your prayer journal and enjoy the renewal of yourself in the presence of the Almighty One. Thank Him for You fill in the blanks. Find in Him energy to You fill in the blanks.

Then return to serve. Then return to share. It's summer. Enjoy the life God has given you.

Update on the church front door project. Building doesn't go according to my plan. That's all right, it's the way it is. First, I was asked to pay off the first project, the seismic retrofit and roof and enhancement of the interior before the parish could take on new debt. We did that. Now, the architect, engineers, and the Diocese are in consultation regarding the doors. That is nearly finished. The plans must be approved by the City of Fullerton, then construction can begin. The project is still being worked on. Some considerations are the doors themselves, and how they will open and remain open. Please have patience. I'm telling myself those words daily.

In the meantime, we are continuing to collect funds via the second collection, and some direct solicitations, so that we can avoid prolonged debt and interest payments. The door project will cost about \$280,000. Currently we have about \$175,000. That's the purpose of the second collection for "Building Fund" and the direct ask for donations to the doors.

Our PSA is stagnate at the moment. If you have not yet made your contribution, please do so. I encourage EVERYONE, children included, to make a contribution. Some parishes have hundreds of contributions because EVERYONE gives something. What can you give to the PSA campaign? From this point all that is sent to the PSA collection is returned to the parish.

Thank you for your on-going generosity and patience.



R.C.I.A. (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)

RCIA is the process established by the Universal Church for adults to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation - **Baptism**, **Confirmation** and the **Eucharist**. The initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey". Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over several months to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experiences of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faith.

- Adults baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation.


