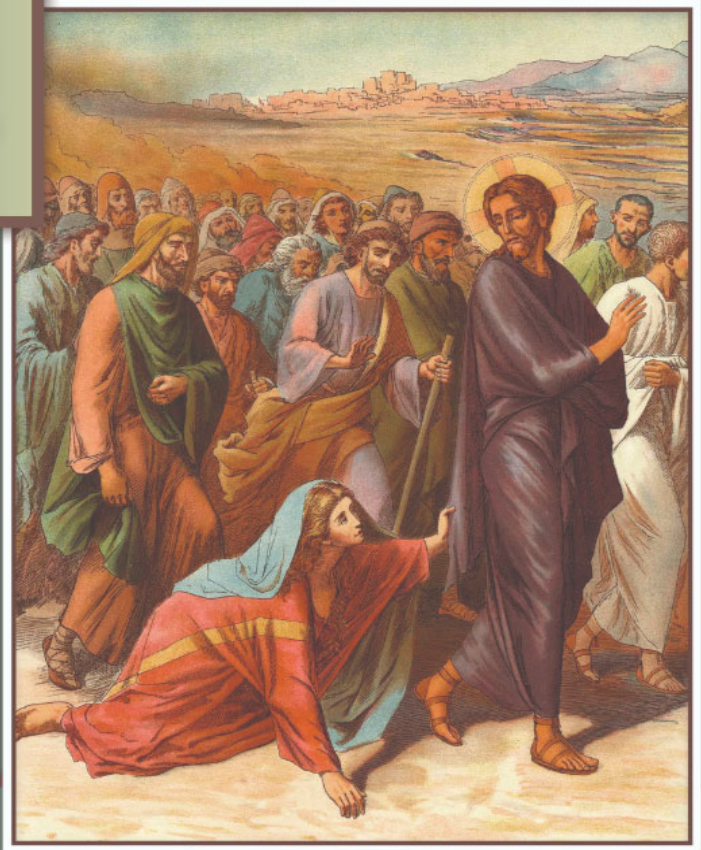

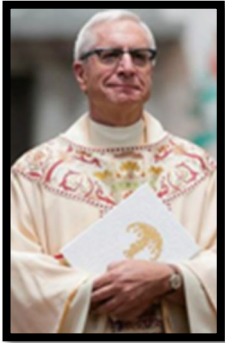

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

The gifts of our patroness, St. Juliana, are community, the Holy Eucharist, and faith formation. Allow these three charisms (gifts) to lead us, her parish, to excellence. Opportunities are presented for faith formation which help us to know and experience one another as community. At Mass we celebrate and praise God, listen to homilies which guide us to holiness and good action, and receive the Holy Eucharist, the True Bread of Heaven. Twenty-four-hour Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on the altar on the first Tuesday of each month is time for spiritual renewal. The PSA rebate and general funds are used to financially support these programs. Are you engaged?

Currently medical awareness and aging-well talks are being presented by professionals each Monday at 7:00PM in our Parish Center. These discussions are for everyone – we will take care of an elder and become elderly ourselves. There is a lot to be learned regarding medical care and funding. These presentations and their discussions are enlightening. They are for YOU, the community of all ages.

During the Sundays of August, the 5th, 12th, and 19th - if all goes as planned – I have scheduled “Faith, Family, Food.” A visiting priest will celebrate the 5:00PM Mass which will be followed by a catered meal, and a talk. It’s a time to worship, share a meal as a community, and learn about our faith. It’s not a triple, it’s not even a home run, it’s a grand slam! One of the presenters is a Servite Priest, the Provincial of the Province of the Isles (England and Ireland), Fr. Paul Addison, OSM.

ALL children should be educated in the faith – not just prepared for sacraments, but educated so they will be converted with the strength of their person to “Know, Love, and Serve God.” Conversion is intellectual - the “know” part. It is affective - the “love” part. And it is moral - the “serve” and “act” part. Registration for the School of Religious Education is continuing and Vacation Bible School is in its final stages of preparation. Do you have a child who ought to attend our SRE or Vacation Bible School programs? Enrollment is easy—come to the parish office or find us on line: www.stjulianachurch.org or by contacting Mr. Mike McHenry in the Faith Formation office 714.853.1193. In this way students and parents are led to community, faith education, and love for the Lord.

Mr. Taylor Engel will soon begin to register candidates to begin and continue in the two-year Confirmation preparation course. He also has faith formation and community opportunities for middle school students and those who are in high school but not in Confirmation courses. Faith formation, community, and love for the Lord, especially in the Eucharist, are the gifts he forms and celebrates in his programs. Please contact him directly, 714.869.3826. He will again lead a group of our teens to “Steubenville San Diego” later this summer.

For our parish grammar school, we project an enrollment of about 300 students, Transitional Kindergarten through eighth grade. Faith formation, community, and love for the Lord is the heart of the school. Should you wish to enroll a student or ask about the school, its contact by phone is 714.871.2829. or www.stjulianaschool.org.

Adult Faith Formation opportunities year round are still another way for the parish to be a community, learn our faith, and love our Lord. Offerings are frequent and diverse. Personally, I (Fr. Mike) enjoy planning and when possible presenting adult faith formation. These are best scheduled on Monday evenings. Do your best to be part of the community of faith formation and worship. If you or someone you are related to or know desires to become a Roman Catholic or complete full initiation in our faith, that is the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Eucharist, please contact Mr. McHenry or me.

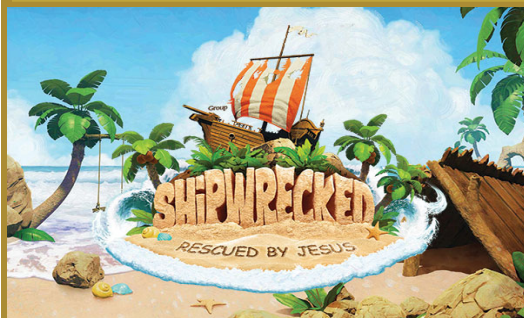

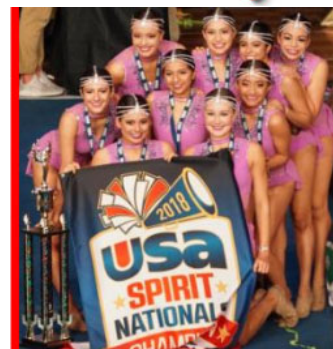

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

As Independence Day draws near, we think of the men and women of the military who serve with courage and competence, some far from home. How does the Church accompany them? In 1939, Pope Pius XII created an independent jurisdiction of the Catholic Church called the "Military Vicariate." In 1985 Pope John Paul II created the "Archdiocese for Military Services, USA." Spanning the globe and serving nearly one and a half million Roman Catholics, more than one thousand priests minister in hospitals, on military bases of all the armed forces, on ships at sea, and on the battlefield. The AMS does not ordain priests, but accepts priests on loan from religious orders and dioceses.

In 1824 a Jesuit priest named Adam Marshall enlisted in the Navy and died at sea in 1825. He was assigned as a "schoolmaster," but he sought out and ministered to Catholic sailors. Twenty years later, President Polk was worried that the war with Mexico was seen as anti-Catholic, so he recruited two Jesuit priests to serve in the army as chaplains. At the time of the Civil War, only about ten percent of Americans were Catholic. Military policies forced Catholic soldiers to attend Protestant services. The Church protested this rule, and many priests volunteered to become chaplains. Their witness and the courage of the "Nuns of the Battlefield" (several orders of sisters who assisted Civil War victims) helped temper prejudice against Catholics and pave the way for the life and ministry of this vigorous and unique archdiocese.
