




THE PARISH AS ONE BODY

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Wednesday, August 15th, is the ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, a holy day of obligation to attend Mass in the United States. At St. Juliana, Mass will be celebrated at 6:30 and 8:00AM and 7:00PM. What are we celebrating as Church on August 15th? What is it about this feast that gathers us this Wednesday in prayer and prompts our conversion?

The Assumption continues the story of the achievement of the impossible. A silly little under-dog TOTALLY REDEEMED in the end of her life ... but redemption started at her birth. The Virgin Mother of God was assumed into heaven as the beginning and image of the Church's coming to perfection and a sign of the sure hope and comfort of the Church for all ages.

To continue the story means that it must have had a beginning. Yes, this story began with the seeming impossibility of the Immaculate Conception as the first pitch, the implausible but picturesque Annunciation, the kind human act of the

Visitation, the watchful eye at the Wedding at Cana, the compassionate place of Mary at the Death of Jesus on the Cross, likewise her presence at the Pentecost - these all keep the score tied. God pitching; Mary hitting to accomplish God's will. Finally, this story comes to its first ending with the walk-off Grand Slam of the Assumption. Then Mary's life is remembered and honoured forever. You see, we are involved in a Double-Header. Tony Bennett and Lady Gaga sing a duet! The Angels win two – silly little underdogs!

The Assumption is a feast of life – a festival of being blessed among all women, a remembrance of what the Almighty has done and continues to do. From her conception until her natural death, Mary was directed toward God; her empty womb brings forth the Savior and filled her and us with many good things. Mary would be the first to recognize Jesus' New Order and live life in a new and more abundant way. She becomes not just Jesus' Mother, but our Mother – a New Eve, the Mother of a New Creation.

Our faith finds roots and courage to grow in Mary's trust in the Lord. She never allowed herself to get into the way of what is holy or what would make her holy.

The Assumption is a celebration of life – that it is holy from its conception and that it is directed always toward the "things of heaven" until life continues in heaven itself. Let us allow Mary to invite us into intimacy with God and all of Humanity. So that death itself is destroyed. As

always we go forth to Glorify the Lord in Our Life.




STRENGTHENED BY THE BREAD OF LIFE

Today we resume the "Bread of Life" discourse from John's Gospel that began two weeks ago. He makes reference to the Jews' ancestors who ate manna in the desert. These days we would think primarily of Israel wandering in the desert, but faithful Jews would also have known the story of Elijah that we hear today. Strengthened by food and drink in the desert, the angel of the Lord sends him on his forty-day and forty-night journey (the biblical number for a preparation time). Like the food given to Elijah in the desert, Jesus tells his listeners that he is bread for the life of the world. It is very important that we not stop listening to Jesus after his promise of eternal life—a marvelous promise, but this "reward" is not the only reason we feast on the Bread of Life. We also come to the table to be made strong for the journey

of mission, that the whole world might have life in the fullness of Christ. We are compelled, if we have eaten of the bread of life, to go forth in service to all.




