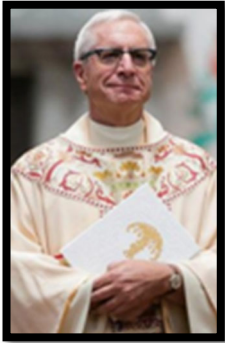

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Greetings All

Bishop Vann has written a letter to the Diocese. Part of it is below, the complete letter is found on **the Diocese of Orange Website: WWW.RCBO.ORG (Roman Catholic Bishop of Orange.ORG).**

“My dear sisters and brothers in the Lord,

It is with the utmost sorrow that I write to you in this time of great scandal and tribulation in our Church. Many people in leadership, particularly among the episcopacy, have failed the people of God. There can be no ambiguity about this.

As your spiritual father and the shepherd of this Diocese, I have prayed, struggled, and reflected a great deal these past few weeks in order to determine how I can best serve you.

The release of the Pennsylvania’s Grand Jury report yesterday (August 14, 2018) confirms that we who lead the Church have a great responsibility to take action against a predation that can only be called satanic.

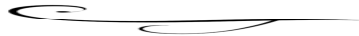
After I was appointed to our Diocese I began to meet regularly with our Oversight Review Board, whose charge it is to advise me on matters concerning accusations of sexual abuse of a minor perpetrated by a cleric. Based on the painful experiences in my home Diocese of Springfield, Illinois during Bishop Daniel Ryan’s tenure which resulted in a devastating loss of trust, I wanted to take every opportunity to create a truly safe environment, including reviewing allegations involving adults, not just minors. I regularly seek the members of this group to offer their observations and advice on a variety of matters that came to the attention of the Diocese. Their counsel has been invaluable and a great help in dealing with matters of misconduct, regarding both clerical and lay matters. Their membership includes ten lay experts, one priest, and one religious sister. Five diocesan employees also staff the Board, three of whom are clergy and two lay. I am grateful to all of the members for their sage advice and willingness to serve. In addition, I urge anyone who has been a victim of clerical abuse in our Diocese to report the abuse by calling our toll free number: (800) 364-3064.

In light of the revelations surrounding Archbishop McCarrick, not to mention the situations in Honduras and Chile, I now know that the review process needs to be expanded to include claims from seminarians and priests so that they, too, are protected from sexual abuse by those in power. Additionally, I will review our process with my leadership team to confirm that it is as robust as possible.

Consider sound moral direction: Pause before any action that you are going to do or is going to be done to or with you. No matter with whom or where this takes place: Is this a truly human act? Is it illegal, immoral, or unsafe? Is it in accord with what I know to be the moral teaching of my Church? Pause: Pinocchio was told to “give a little whistle” – do AT LEAST THAT much. Pause: think, pray, then act. Get advice from another person – family or church. Come to church and pray. If the action is wrong do not act. If you are in doubt, do not act. Do not follow Nike’s motto: “Just Do It” – you can get into a whole lot of trouble by just acting without thinking! “Everybody knows, everybody says, everybody is doing it” does not make the act moral or legal or safe. Even if it is right, you don’t know why!



Thank you, each of you, who attended our Faith Night - Parish Mission Series. I hope you experienced good community, worship, and faith formation. **Community, Worship, Faith Formation – it’s who we are and what we are about at the Parish of St. Juliana Falconieri.** I am most grateful to Msgr. Michael Heher and Fr. Paul Addison, OSM who presented valuable lessons to us. To Mr. Curtis Wesseln and volunteers and staff who helped in so many ways, thank you. We are all in debt to those who have contributed to the 2018 PSA campaign – the parish rebate paid for these nights. Now is the time to build the community of believers – our church community. We’ve erected and enhanced physical structures, it’s the community - YOU the People of God who are the treasure of St. Juliana Falconieri Parish.



Please kneel while saying/singing “GRANT US PEACE” at the Lamb of God – **at the END OF THE LAMB OF GOD.** Ministers come to the sanctuary AS the priest/celebrants are receiving Holy Communion. The changes are to gain a greater respect for the Holy Eucharist always present in the center of our church. It’s a Roman Catholic Church with the Eucharist present in its center that we enter and leave. For that reason, kindly genuflect when you enter and leave the church.
