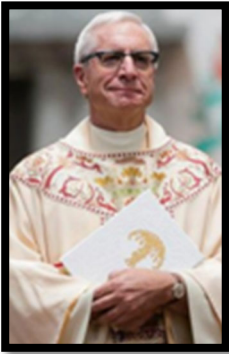

The Feast of the Epiphany of The Lord is a major feast. It's a national holiday in Italy. In many parts of our Catholic Church it is celebrated on January 6, the Twelfth Day of Christmas itself, it is not moved to a Sunday. This year January 6<sup>th</sup> is a Sunday. Some parts of our Christian faith celebrate Epiphany as "Little Christmas." It's a feast of lights, travel, gifts, and wise people.

**Lights.** Jesus' own light directed the new comers from where they were to where Jesus is. It's a conversion lesson. Let the Light of Christ, the Light of Faith change your life. There is a competing light; Lucifer, the name means light and his light is also very attractive. Come to the light of Christ; especially that bright light which is the light of the Easter candle, the light that says there is no darkness of sin or death. Come to it - your life will be changed.

**Travel.** Where do you go to find the Lord? I appreciate Christians who come to the church imitating our ancestors who set out to find Jesus. He is ever present here in the sacrament of his Body, in the Word of Scripture, and in the community of the baptized. To everyone who comes to find Jesus here at St. Juliana Parish, welcome! Find the Lord also in the beauty of creation, in all creatures great and small. Imitate the wise people we celebrate today and find the Lord. Live life in such a way that you say: "WOW, thank you Lord for all you have given to me and us."

**Gifts.** Scripture tells us very little about these gift-bearing travelers who came to Jesus. Were there three? Were they men? Well, there were three gifts. One man for each gift. Who would want to buy more expensive statues for the manger scene anyway? How might we up-date a gift list? Accept and give the good gifts of compassion, hope, trust, honesty, joy, faith, and love. These will replace unwanted selfishness, fear, pettiness, anger, doubt, and deceit.

**Gifts.** Thank you, everyone for your gifts given to St. Juliana and me during Christmas. I may have entered a tax bracket! I will have to enter a weight loss program! Thank you for the extra gifts you gave St. Juliana to support our ministry. Thank you for the gift of being part of this community.

**Wise people.** The ones we celebrate today sought the truth that would set them free. Seek wisdom in our faith formation opportunities. We have the gift of a faith-formation opportunity I want you to share with all of your friends in any school or community – Professor Jean Twenge – I am over-the-moon delighted to welcome her to St. Juliana on January 13 and 14. Especially on Monday, January 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30PM come with your family and friends who are not part of this community, maybe not of our faith, to hear her speak about iGen, our young generation born after 1995, the first generation to have been raised with the internet, hence iGen. Come young and come elderly. It's paid for with PSA funds and a very generous donation. To prepare yourselves, find San Diego State University Professor Jean Twenge on YouTube or Google.

An epiphany is a privileged moment when our guards are down, when our calculating intellects are caught off guard, and the God who defies definition jumps out of the ordinary, ambushes us from within the commonplace. Make a journey of faith to learn more about who you are and what you can accept and give. Faith formation at St. Juliana ought to be your destination.

For the January 13 and 14 faith-formation event, prepare to hear such topics as: Many parents have no idea what their children are doing on social media and feel helpless. Are video games a social encounter? What is the effect of screen time replacing socializing and reading? Today's bullies aren't pushing students into lockers...they cower behind user names and fake profiles and berate and abuse good, innocent people. From Professor Twenge's experience and research she will speak about iGen students as they come to college with less experience reading, how they are met where they are, while the professor must teach them what they need to know. She is insightful!

ADULT CONFIRMATION

This sacrament, like baptism, may only be celebrated once.

It is closely linked with baptism in that there is an anointing with oil (Chrism), laying on of hands, and special activity of the Holy Spirit.

When celebrated *apart* from Baptism & First Holy Communion, the bishop or a priest designated by him is the minister of Confirmation.

## JEAN M. TWENGE, PHD - JANUARY 13 AND 14, 2019

The iGen is the first generation to spend their entire childhood in the age of the smartphone, and this fact alone seems to have an important impact on who they are and how they relate to the world. More than previous generations, they are obsessed with safety, focused on tolerance, and have no patience for inequality. They are also "on the brink of the worst mental health crisis in decades."

In this lively talk on **January 13 and 14** at our St. Juliana Parish Center we will explore the idea that iGen may be growing up more slowly than previous generations. Also, learn what practical tools may be utilized to best meet the developmental needs of children and encourage their independence and autonomy.

**Jean Twenge**, Ph.D, is a professor of Psychology at San Diego State University and the author of more than 140 scientific publications and books, including *iGen: Why Today's Super-Connected Kids Are Growing Up Less Rebellious, More Tolerant, Less Happy-and Completely Unprepared for Adulthood*. Dr. Twenge frequently gives talks and seminars on teaching and working with today's young generation based on a dataset of 11 million young people. Her research has appeared in *The Atlantic* and *The New York Times* (to name a few) and she has been featured on the Today Show, NBC Nightly News, Fox & Friends, NPR and CNN.
