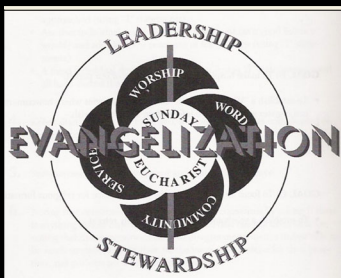

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



When I was a lot younger, I used to hang out at the Grand Hotel across the street from Disneyland during baseball season. I did this for two reasons; on hot afternoons, I would swim in the hotel pool and because visiting baseball teams used to stay there. I asked the ball players to sign autographs. By the end of the season, I had a zillion autographs. Sometimes the players would talk to us kids, usually not. Most were kind at best. I was thrilled; the occasion made my day, not theirs. They just did it. I used to hang out after the games at “The Big A” to get Angel autographs. It was a bigger deal for me than for the players. Again, they just did it. There used to be a theatre in the round, called MelodyLand near the Grand Hotel. “The Stars” used to perform there. The Smothers Brothers, Liberace, Phyllis Diller, and a bunch of others, I got their autographs too. A bigger deal for me than for the star. Most were kind, writing their name was a function of fame; it was something they just did. Eventually Mom threw all of those autographs away. A bigger deal for me than for her!

So, here’s today’s Gospel scene: the tax collector, a wealthy man, gets an idea: “I wanna see this famous guy, Jesus. He is in town. I’m short in stature. Better climb up a sycamore tree. Ya think he’ll even notice me?” If that’s one question, there’s another. “What made Jesus stop and set up a dinner date with Zacchaeus?”

Zacchaeus, the name means “the innocent one” – that’s irony! He is as innocent as ... Al Capone. The man was a racketeer, a collaborator, a real crook. That’s how he got rich! Jesus stopped and invited himself to Zacchaeus’ house. That would be like the bishop stopping to invite himself to a party at Heffner’s mansion along with Heff’s stable of fancy models. How would that escape any news?

Then Jesus spoke this line of purpose to Zacchaeus: “Today, salvation has come to this house!” Hey, Zacchaeus: You want to see me, I’m coming over to be with you.

What is expected of the model Christian? Do as Zacchaeus did, make an effort to know Jesus. Expect Jesus’ same response; you are worth my time. Let’s talk about our relationship over dinner.

Jesus told everyone he/she is important. Jesus offered a meal of love and ordered others to do the same. The time together offers salvation, a moon-shot farther than “I just gotta do it” gestures.

The stars signed their names, they just did it.

Generally, I’m not a fan of Nike’s theme: “Just Do It” – but, when it comes to hospitality and gestures of compassion or when it comes to offering an invitation to know Jesus, “Just do it.” It’s so basic.

Be the presence of Jesus to others today, He is Truly Present to you. Offer all people a better life, open a door, greet them kindly, and welcome them into your life and our home, St. Juliana Parish Community. Offer salvation, an invitation to know, love, and serve God.

Just do it! You’ll be glad you did!

Orders will be taken after each Mass the weekends of Nov 16, 23 and 30. Delivery is on the weekend of December 7th.

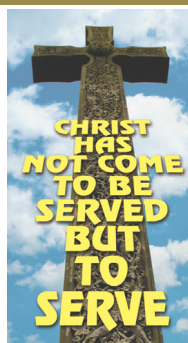

NEW CHAIRMAN FOR THE PARISH RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY NEEDED

At the end of 2019, Barbara Legas, who has served in the parish Respect Life Group for **43 years** (with the last 30 years as chairman) will be retiring. *There is a need for someone to take over as chairman.* Barbara will be at the Respect Life table at the Ministry Fair this Sunday, so anyone who might feel called to do this work can talk to her.

The need for this ministry is just as great now as it was 43 years ago, when Abortion was legalized in America with the *Roe v Wade* Supreme Court Decision. Both the beginning of life, in the womb, and the end of life years continue to be threatened as never before. At least 9 states have passed bills this year to make it legal to kill babies immediately after a live birth. And many states, at the other end of life's spectrum, have legalized assisted suicide over the last several years. **It would be nice to have someone in place before the start of 2020, as January has many Pro-Life events in the Diocese** (the 44th anniversary of *Roe v Wade*; Jan. 14-22 is the 9 DAYS FOR LIFE; Saturday, January 18 is ONE LIFE LA (walk for life); and Wednesday, January 22 is the MASS FOR LIFE at the Christ Cathedral.) The next 40 DAYS FOR LIFE PRAYERVIGILS at Planned Parenthood start on Ash Wednesday, February 26 and continues daily until Palm Sunday.

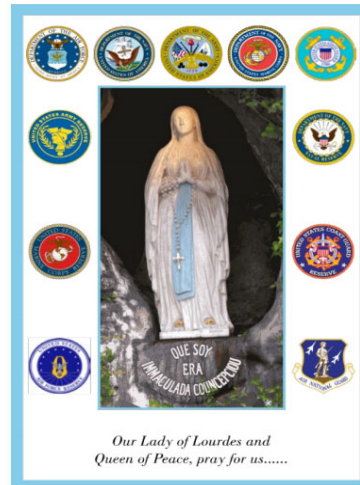

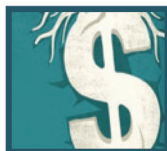

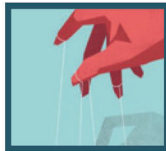
