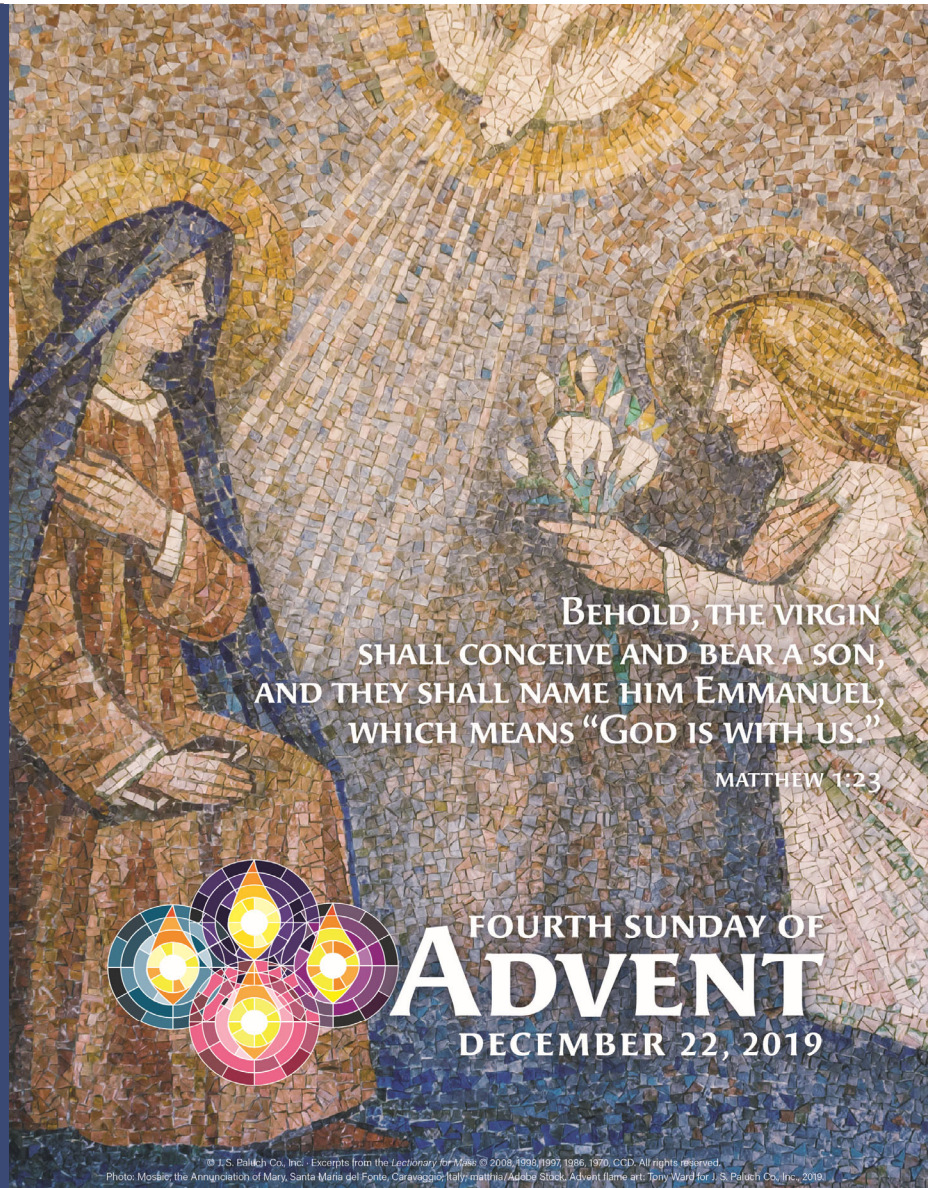

**A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M**

When was the last time you were obedient – to an angel who appeared to you in a dream? Sounds crazy, no?

My grey haired curmudgeon years began when I was quite young! I've found myself beating up various artistic images for a long time. Our image of Jesus is most likely not the Jesus who was the son of the carpenter. And the carpenter, Joseph, what about him? He's usually painted as an old man. Why? Could it be that he was older than Mary and there would be something wrong about painting Mary as a young woman and Joseph as an old husband?

There is no scriptural evidence to support Joseph as being old but there is nothing to suggest otherwise either.

Study Joseph as a younger man. Perhaps Joseph is suddenly more appealing, Mary too. They are a more ordinary couple with still an extraordinary call. Arguing Joseph's image and age is to miss the point.

What we know is Joseph is betrothed to a young girl in his village. He is hard working before they are married. He suddenly discovers that she is pregnant. How could she explain it in any way that he could accept the truth?

Thus the turmoil in Joseph's mind and the truth of the teaching. What Mary claimed was unthinkable. Either Mary had lost her mind or she was unfaithful to Joseph before they were married. Joseph, the upright man, was unwilling to shame her with open divorce. He must have thought of some scheme. Mary could go off to Elizabeth's house and wait for the child. Or...

Then one night Joseph suddenly came awake from a dream so real he knew it was no ordinary dream. God had solved his dilemma. This Child was conceived of God. In addition, his name was to be Jesus: God saves, because he would be the embodiment of God among human beings.

When you find a challenge in your life, how do you allow God to intrude with an answer? What might God tell you except to look at the situation in a new way? A way that will give you life and respect the life of others.

You've had God challenges lately. With the help of God you've gotten through them.

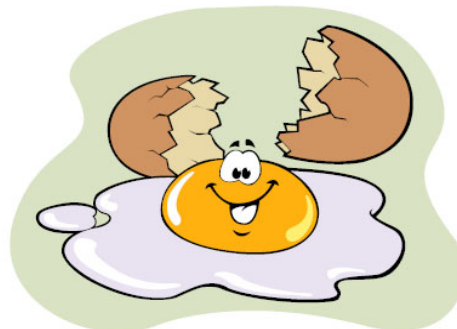

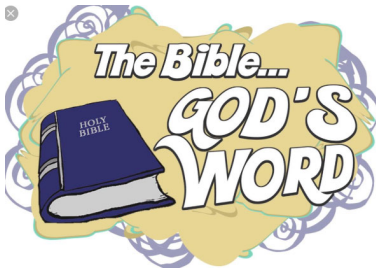

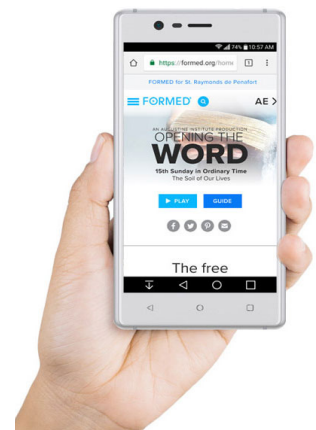

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

An old joke asks, “What time is Midnight Mass?” (At St. Juliana Church, our Solemn Mass starts at 10:30pm! ☺ ) The answer is not really obvious, since Christmas is unique in having several distinct celebrations. The readings and prayers vary greatly from hour to hour. The Vigil Mass hinges on the family heritage of Jesus and his origins. The concept of “midnight” predates clock time, and really has to do with a celebration in the hours of darkness. Years ago, it was not possible to receive Communion without fasting for a full day, so the late hour of this Mass made it possible for the people to receive. The first Mass after sunrise, the Mass at Dawn, was once known as “The Shepherds’ Mass,” and later Masses set aside stories of Jesus’ birth to focus on the key to the day’s celebration: John the Evangelist’s majestic theology of Christ’s identity as the Word made flesh, dwelling among us. One feast, four separate Masses. Only monasteries manage the whole round. Parishioners typically take just one entry point into the mystery. Yet there is much to savor and celebrate in the coming of Christ into the world. Christmas is not a day, but a season. You still have two weeks to send those Christmas cards before you’re officially late!

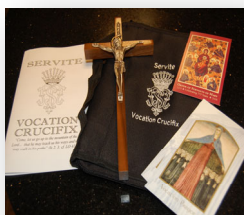

## 12 DAYS OF CHRISTMAS

When most people hear of "The 12 Days of Christmas", they think of the song. This song had its origins as a teaching tool to instruct young people in the meaning and content of the Christian faith. Each of the items in the song represents something of religious significance. The hidden meaning of each gift was designed to help young Christians learn their faith.

The song goes, "On the first day of Christmas my true love gave to me..."

The "true love" represents God and the "me" who receives these presents is the Christian. Here you go:

The "partridge in a pear tree" was Jesus Christ who died on a tree as a gift from God.

The "two turtle doves" were the Old and New Testaments - another gift from God.

The "three French hens" were faith, hope and love - the three gifts of the Spirit that abide (I Corinthians 13).

The "four calling birds" were the four Gospels which sing the song of salvation through Jesus Christ.

The "five golden rings" were the first five books of the Bible also called the "Books of Moses".

The "six geese a-laying" were the six days of creation.

The "seven swans a swimming" were the "seven gifts of the Holy Spirit". (I Corinthians 12:8-11; Romans 12, Ephesians 4; I Peter 4:10-11).

The "eight maids a milking" were the eight beatitudes.

The "nine ladies dancing" were nine fruits of the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 5:22 & 23)

The "ten lords a-leaping" were the Ten Commandments.

The "eleven pipers piping" were the eleven faithful disciples.

The "twelve drummers drumming" were the twelve points of the Apostles' Creed.



So, the next time you hear "The 12 Days of Christmas", consider how this otherwise non-religious sounding song had its origins in the Christian faith.

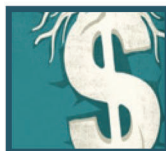

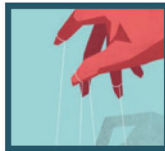
