A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

It could be I'm just unconventional. After a conversation or two some folks tell me: "You're just an old curmudgeon!" I usually respond, "I remember when I was called a young curmudgeon." Can't help it, Andy Rooney, a happy memory, was a hero. Google or YouTube Andy Rooney. You'll giggle in two hours.

The over-use of words, really precious words, gets under my skin. Frankly it fuses the fillings in my mouth. Love, excellence, and fulfillment are but three words that are over-used. Their over-use means they seldom mean what they were intended to mean.

'Ja ever take a good moment and reflect on what love, excellence, and fulfillment might really mean?

Today's second reading from St. Paul is quite precious by itself. I encourage you to read and reflect on it often. Do it as a family while eating Sunday pasta or your morning Coco Puffs.

In a reading that is commonly used at weddings, I Cor 12:31-13:13, St. Paul tells us that love is "a still more excellent way" to live. He continues to tell us what love is and what it is not. St. Paul tells us that love is the way to fulfillment. Note very carefully, love is neither "huggy-bear" nor is it "kissy-face." Love is not romance, infatuation, nor is it sex. Love is not a feeling; it is an act of the will. Love kicks in when feelings fail. Love is not selfish. Neither does it rejoice over wrongdoing. It is an excellent decision, the most excellent act one can make for the good of others. Love is an act of the will; a choice made to be fulfilled. Webster's dictionary doesn't tell us that, the study of God, theology, does.

Excellence, says the old curmudgeon, is another over-used shibboleth, a catch-word used so often it lacks meaning. Think of one organization celebrating an anniversary that does not raise itself to excellence: "Clogged Drain Plumbing celebrates 50 years of excellence." I'm not sure what that really means; I had a bad experience with those stinky plumbers who didn't have the right tools. Mom told me long ago: "It's a bad carpenter who complains of his tools" –plumbers are the same. Mom ran one service man after the other out of the house. She wanted excellence not excuses.

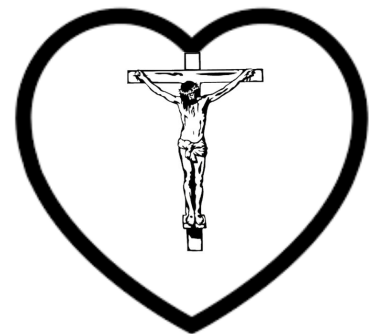
Fulfillment is not success or happiness. Success is gauged; it's a certain grade on a test, the team's standing at the end of a season, the result after surgery. Happiness is the excitement of a thrill. Fulfillment is a moon-shot more than success or happiness. Fulfillment is completing what you were meant to be.

Jesus taught love is service to others. Just look at every crucifix. A man all used up in service. That's human fulfillment. That's excellence. Jesus fulfilled what he was sent to do; reveal to us who God is and what He is all about. Read the Gospels, when he brought the Good News of His father to all people he completed the role of Messiah, the revelation of God, he was meant to be. Yet, some people were "filled with fury" and sought ways to destroy him.

Why wasn't he acceptable everywhere? Maybe because he wasn't all that conventional. How would we have treated the unconventional Jesus?

Do you or we treat other unconventional folks any differently?

Love is the "still more excellent way". To be fulfilled, strive to love excellently.

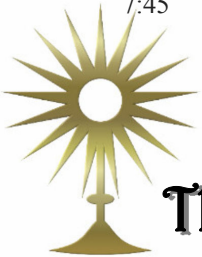

Things to do during Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the living God.

Fr Benedict Groeschel points out in *“In the Presence of Our Lord: The History, Theology, and Psychology of Eucharistic Devotion”* that there are ‘four kinds of prayer most appropriate in the presence of the Eucharist, namely **adoration and praise, thanksgiving, repentance, and trusting intercession.**’ Here are suggestions what to do during private Eucharistic adoration.

1. PRAY THE PSALMS OR THE LITURGY OF THE HOURS

Whether you are praising, giving thanks, asking for forgiveness, or seeking an answer, you’ll find an appropriate psalm. The ancient prayer of the Church called the Liturgy of the Hours presents an excellent way to pray through the Book of Psalms throughout the year.

2. RECITE THE “JESUS PRAYER”

Say “Lord Jesus, have mercy on me, a sinner”, repeatedly as you quiet your heart and mind.

3. MEDITATE USING SCRIPTURE

Choose a passage from the Bible. Read the words and ask God to let the passage speak to you. Pay special attention to anything that strikes you and ask God what He wishes for you to draw from that passage.

4. READ THE LIFE OF A SAINT AND PRAY WITH HIM OR HER

Most holy men and women have a great devotion to Our Lord in the Eucharist. Therese of Lisieux, Catherine of Siena, Francis of Assisi, Thomas Aquinas, Peter Julian Eymard, Dorothy Day, Mother Teresa of Calcutta, and Baroness Catherine de Hueck are just a few. Read about them and pray their prayers before the Blessed Sacrament.

5. POUR OUT YOUR HEART TO CHRIST AND ADORE HIM

Speak to Jesus, aware that you are in His presence, and tell Him all that comes to your mind. Listen for His response. Pray the prayer that St Francis instructed his brothers to pray whenever they were before the Blessed Sacrament: “I adore you, O Christ, present here and in all the churches of the world, for by your holy cross you have redeemed the world.”

6. ASK FOR FORGIVENESS AND INTERCEDE FOR OTHERS

Think of those who have hurt you and request a special blessing for them. Ask God to forgive you for all the times you have neglected or hurt someone else. Bring before the Blessed Sacrament all those who have asked you to pray for them. Ask the Lord to address their concerns.

7. PRAY THE ROSARY

Pope John Paul II reminds us, “. . .is not the enraptured gaze of Mary as she contemplated the face of the newborn Christ and cradled him in her arms that unparalleled model of love which should inspire us every time we receive Eucharistic Communion?” (The Church and the Eucharist, 55) Ask Mary to join you as you gaze on Christ in the Eucharist and as you pray the Rosary.

8. SIT QUIETLY AND JUST “BE” IN THE PRESENCE OF GOD

Think of a visit to the Blessed Sacrament as coming to see your best friend. Sit quietly and enjoy being in each other’s company. Instead of talking to the Lord, try listening to what He wants to tell you.

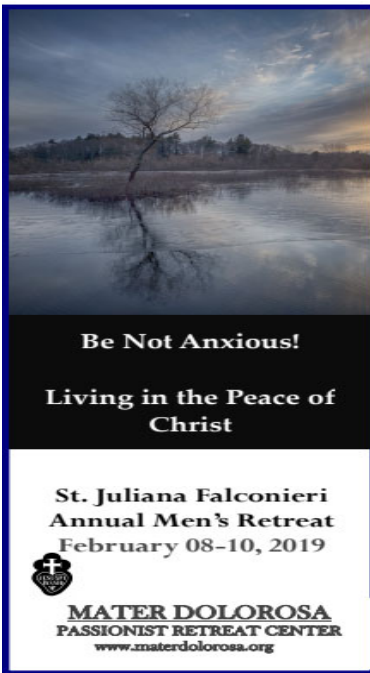

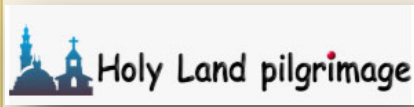


