A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M.

Every now and again engage your family with this question: “If you had unchallengeable evidence that Jesus had really come back and ended up in your city, where would you go looking for him? Knowing his motives, his MO from all you have read, studied, heard about and important too – experienced – where would Jesus be and what would he be doing?”

The most effective brain-washing happens while you don’t even know it’s occurring. It happens with every advertisement you read, hear, and see. You never thought you would need “new and improved” Fritos, Coke, spaghetti, or Coco Puffs? Slap “new and improved” on the label and you’ll buy it. Who wants the same old stuff? You’re caught by the ad and sent to the grocery store. And the advertisement works in about thirty seconds. “Come to me my precious, buy and use this, you’ll be happier! Take this and you will be like God! I want you to have life in abundance! Buy and use *Not Bread* today!”

Didn’t you know that *Not Bread* was your deepest desire? They did!

Reflect on today’s Gospel passage: Do you find it strange that Jesus caught fishermen doing their work - fishing? Do you find it strange that he – a land hugging carpenter - taught fishermen how to fish in questionable deep water? Yet it happened. They went into the deep. What was he advertising?

Jesus knew enough to tell those fishermen: “The more fish you have, the happier you will be. Fill your nets and you will be fulfilled. After all you are fishermen.” At first they resisted. But once they followed, their catch was abundant. To be fulfilled the fishermen needed fish. And Jesus knew it.

Psst: He knows who you are and what you need. Jesus knows how to raise you to new life. That’s what he is selling. He’s doing it in his Church.

Our deepest desire is to be in a relationship with God through Jesus His son. We aren’t different from those fishermen in today’s Gospel lesson. It didn’t happen a long time ago in a far-away land. It happens when we encounter Jesus today. Is Jesus as attractive as an advertisement that creates a craving?

Jesus is disguised in everyone who is telling you to find yourself as a gifted child of God. He is ever present in each sacrament that is calling you to new and abundant life: you are a child of God (Baptism), this is my body; take and eat and you will live (Eucharist), your sins are forgiven (Penance), be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit (Confirmation), what God has joined let nobody separate (Marriage), through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit (Sacrament of the Sick), you are consecrated for service (Holy Orders). Jesus is calling you to a relationship with him. That relationship will allow you to develop and use your talents so that you can make a difference in the community. Does he stand a chance of catching you? Will you allow yourself to be sent to those who do not know Jesus but through you?

Jesus’ voice is often drowned out by competing voices. The same happened to the voice of his Father in the Garden. A serpent once offered: “Eat this and you will be like God.” All God wants is for the crown of His creation to be fulfilled; holy. Live the life you are given in a relationship with Jesus.

Which offers you more; faith formation or today’s distraction? Where do you find Jesus?

Which option offers truth?

Nifty questions.

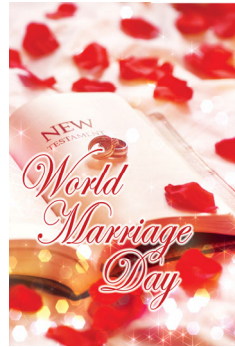

World Day of the Sick

The World Day of the Sick, February 11th, instituted in 1992 by St. John Paul II is celebrated every year on the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes, for all believers who seek "a special time of prayer and sharing, of offering one's suffering". St John Paul II wrote a great deal on the topic of suffering (especially once he was diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease) and believed that suffering was very much a salvific and a redeeming process through Christ.

In 2018, Pope Francis wrote: "The memory of this long history of service to the sick is cause for rejoicing on the part of Christian community, and especially those presently engaged in this ministry. Yes, we must look to the past above all to let it enrich us. We should learn the lesson it teaches us about the self-sacrificing generosity of many founders of institutes in the service of the infirm, the creativity, prompted by charity, of many initiatives undertaken over the centuries, and the commitment to scientific research as a means of offering innovative and reliable treatments to the sick. This legacy of the past helps us to build a better future, for example, by shielding Catholic hospitals from the business mentality that is seeking worldwide to turn health care into a profit-making enterprise, which ends up discarding the poor."
