



The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is celebrated each year on August 6th. It is also the reading for the Second Sunday of Lent regardless of the lectionary cycle; A, B, or C. It's loaded with material for dynamic spiritual reflection.

Reflect on the scene and recognize a parallel between the transfiguration and the agony in the garden. The cast of characters is pretty much the same: Jesus, Peter, James, and John. The apostles are relatively clueless. The scene: a hillside where Jesus went to pray.

Then the parallel ends. In the transfiguration, Jesus' divinity suddenly blazes through the temporary reality of his body. The disciples are stunned. In contrast, during the agony, there's nothing left of Jesus but a pleading with his Father not to make him go through the next day of humiliation and torture. And the disciples close their eyes.

Consider Peter. In the transfiguration the only thought Peter has is putting up some monument to the occasion: tents for Jesus, Moses, and Elijah. And Luke says flat out: "He didn't really know what he was saying." Because he had no idea what was going on. All he knew was the awesome sense of Jesus' other-worldliness. Now, this was more like it!

This is eye awakening expectation of all followers of Jesus; the awesome sense of Jesus' other-worldliness. But, of course, he didn't know what he was talking about. He couldn't comprehend that the only way to Jesus' real glorification was up the side of another hill, Calvary. And as at his final transfiguration there would be two men on either side of him, too, but this time not the lawgiver and the prophet but two executed felons.

Paradox is at the very root of the gospels, a complete upending of our expectations: If you want the first place, take the last place; If you want to find yourself, you have to lose yourself; Blessed are those who mourn, who are persecuted, who are insulted. In the end, in the sublimest of paradoxes, Jesus triumphs because he has surrendered himself utterly to the inscrutable will of his Father.

What Peter, in his world-bound view could not comprehend, was that the Jesus of the hill of transfiguration was the same Jesus of the hill of Calvary, that suffering is the way to glory, that loss is the doorway to gain, that the wrath of God is the love of God, assessed by a fool.

So we progress this Lent from the hill of the transfiguration to the hill of Calvary.

Good journey! Stay the course! With our souls fixed on the Lord let us glorify Him with the way we live our life.




