We speak of Lent as a “sacred time” - “a time of grace”. Why so? Because Lent is THAT time of the liturgical year our Church gives us to “find the center.” In Lent we recognize that we are people who have “lost our way.” We are God’s people who need to return to the Lord. During Lent we renew our relationships, with the Lord our God and each other. During Lent we turn from that which does not lead us to God and His love, we turn from anger to forgiveness. We do it to be renewed, Easter people.



During Lent ask: “What is the center of my life and does it hold?” During Lent ask yourself: “Is my life centered on Christ and his message of love and service? Or is something else the center? Do I live in such a way that my life gives glory to the Lord?” Be honest in your answer! Do the neighbors and my co-workers know that I am a Catholic Christian?

The Lenten Mass readings, especially the weekday readings, offer a guide to deeper Christian life. Use them as instruction to turn away from sin and return to the Gospel. **Turn from vice, and practice virtue, the nice.** Access and meditate on the daily readings at [www.USCCB.org](http://www.USCCB.org). Or attend daily Mass!

Yes, quit vicious habits which separate us from God and one another. Practice the good habits of virtues which are unifying. Reflect on the vice of anger and its antidote the virtue of **forgiveness**. Is anger your center? Some anger is necessary and acceptable. However, to be consumed by anger, especially petty anger is not good: “You slighted me and you are going to pay for it for the rest of your life. I don’t like you. I will make your life miserable and wipe you out!” Your life will be no better! You are swallowing poison, hoping that your enemy dies! YOU are dead – dead to living your life freely.

When anger controls of your life, it is your center. You are marked: “He’s angry.” Anger is your name.

**Practice forgiveness, peace** the fullness of life, not simply the absence of conflict, and **empathy**.

Peter asked: “**Lord, how often must I forgive my brother?**” Jesus’ response: “**Always**, and from your heart.” (Mt 18:21-35) Practice forgiveness. Spend Lent as a time to practice virtue, at Easter your life will be filled with good habits. Practice will make you perfect – “Be perfect as your Father is perfect!”

Peacemaking - “non-violent communication”- takes patience, practice, and skill. The results are worth every bit of the effort. Take a moment to Google **Non-Violent Communication** under the name Marshall Rosenberg, PhD. His books inform and inspire the practice of many virtuous habits and could well prevent relationships from breaking up. Practice his method, it works splendidly. When the center, empathy, does not hold, communication fails with the results of division, conflict, unrest, and anger.

To inspire forgiveness, peace and empathy, here is a guide to heartfelt authentic communication. Connect with others using a simple formula: “When I see/hear/notice, I feel, because I need/value. So, would you be willing to...? When I see you read the newspaper while I am talking, I feel abandoned because I’m wanting to connect with you. Would you be willing to close the paper and hear my thoughts?” (taken from a Rosenberg Google page). **Nota Bene:** These words are to be spoken; never sent through text, Twitter, Facebook, email, or another electronic media platform which is replacing authentically human empathic communication!

Empathic connections are essential to all healthy relationships. With empathy, anger can be lessened, trust increased, and a richer life enjoyed.

Learn and practice virtue, turn from vice – eliminate the naughty, become authentically nice! Lent is a sacred time. Practice being holy, perfect the practice.

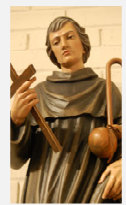

**RCIA SCRUTINIES - INFO YOU MIGHT LIKE TO KNOW**

The RCIA Scrutinies are very special rites celebrated on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sunday’s of Lent, at liturgies where the RCIA Elect are present. The Elect are those in our midst who are preparing for Baptism (at the great Easter Vigil). Part of their journey, to the font at Easter, is that they have been received among us (the Rite of Welcome and Acceptance), and they have been enrolled in the Book of the Elect (the Rite of Election). Now, during Lent, we celebrate three Scrutinies with our Elect, and continue to pray for them during their final preparations for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation).

Even if you are not at a Mass where these rites are celebrated, it can be wonderful to reflect upon the journey the Elect are making during Lent, as an inspiration and source of renewal for us in our journey.

These are ancient RCIA rites and they may, at first, seem strange to us. But they are profoundly rooted in our human experience. Now - during Lent - as we celebrate the Scrutinies, we need to examine (scrutinize) how we are, the areas of our lives where we are tempted, or seriously sin - in what we do and what we fail to do. We really need healing and the strength that can come from the support of our sisters and brothers.

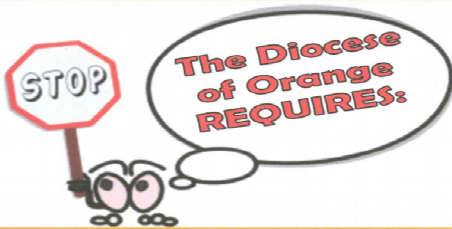

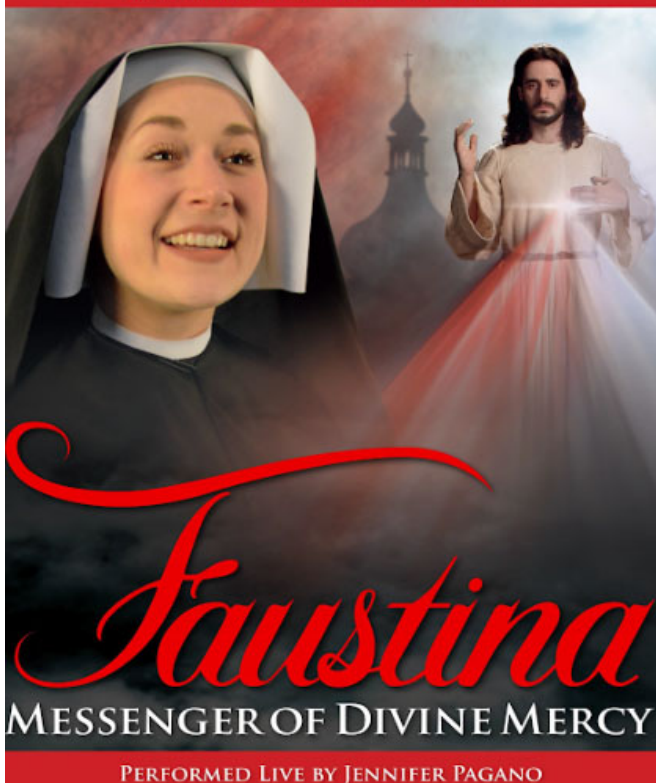

### CORAZON NEWS

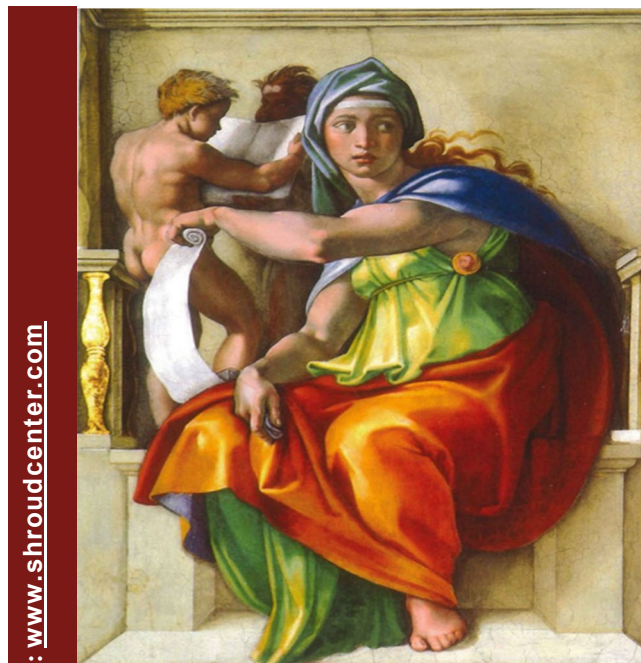

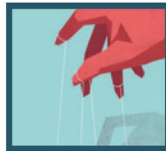
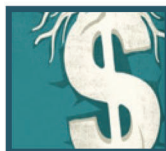
