Lent 2019 begins this Wednesday, March 6th. **Ash Wednesday Mass times are 6:30AM, 8:00AM, 10:30AM, and 7:00PM.** Once more, beginning this Ash Wednesday and lasting for the rest of our lives, each one of us has the opportunity to “Reform your life, return to the Gospel.”

Or not.

Have a plan for the days of Lent which will reform the rest of your life. Here’s the deal. Often we give up something for Lent alone. And somewhat rejoice in forgoing whatever it is. By the end of Lent, we have lost weight, gained muscle mass, saved money by not eating chocolate, perhaps saved a relationship by not drinking alcohol, or began a good practice only to stop on Holy Thursday evening, Lent’s last moment. We effectively gave up something that can last as a habit. We began a good practice, began doing something noble; attending daily Mass, daily meditation, exercising, saying a nice greeting with a smile. Then zowie, back to the old ways! Lent was difficult, but why not daily Mass forever? Well, why not use Lent to form a new habit that will better your life? And recall this gem; the money saved from not buying the cholate,

liquor, or Twinkies was given to the church collection! Don’t say you can’t remember that teaching. We gave up and gave to, that was the sacrifice of Lent.

Use this Lent to change your life. Use this Lent to better your relationship with God and His Church. Direct your life’s faith journey toward the Kingdom of God. Start a new and positive habit for yourself and your family.

Easter is the most life-giving event ever. Whatever you do – give up or begin doing – do it for life. For your life and our life as a community of faith.

Some suggestions:

Accept people - don’t tolerate them.

Be holy - accept the sacrifice, keep the discipline of Lent. Don’t look for the days or times when, “Father, can you dispense me from abstaining from meat this Friday?” will be easier. A sacrifice is a sacrifice to be kept. Keep the days of Lent holy, every one of them.

Pray, even or especially as a family. Attend Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament as a family.

Increase your stewardship to the parish.

Study our faith. Use good web-sites; Bishop Robert Barron for example. Attend faith-formation opportunities of the parish and diocese.

Help one another, even or especially when it’s b-o-r-i-n-g or inconvenient.

Make someone’s day easier. Tell them something special. Write an email. Post a clever, life-giving social media message.

Random acts of kindness practiced often enough can become a habit.

And that’s the point, make being a Catholic Christian a life-giving and life-long habit.

Pray and act on this prayer:

Lord, my church is composed of people like me.
 I help make it what it is.
 It will be friendly if I am.
 Its pews will be filled, if I help fill them.
 It will do great work, if I work.
 It will make generous gifts to many causes,
 if I am a generous giver.
 It will bring other people
 into its worship and fellowship,
 if I invite and bring them.
 It will be a church of loyalty and love,
 of fearlessness and faith,
 and a church with noble spirit,
 if I who make it what it is,
 am filled with these same qualities.
 Therefore, with the help of God,
 I shall dedicate myself to the task of being all the
 things I want my church to be.
 Amen.

Ash Wednesday Mass Schedule

Distribution of Blessed Ashes is during the celebration of Mass on Ash Wednesday, March 6th at **6:30am, 8:00am, 10:30am, and 7:00pm.**

The Lenten season begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6, 2019 and ends with the beginning of the Easter Triduum and the celebration of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 18, 2019. In a particular way during Lent, we are asked to devote ourselves to the spiritual and corporal works of mercy that "remind us that faith finds expression in concrete everyday actions meant to help our neighbors in body and spirit."

The following practices are to be observed by Catholics in the Diocese of Orange in their penitential practices:

- 1) It is to be noted first of all that it is by Divine Law that the faithful are bound to do penance and, as a specification of this obligation by the Church, some form of mortification by those 14 years of age and older is to be observed on all Fridays throughout the year. This obligation is in itself a serious one.
- 2) Everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent. No Catholic will lightly hold himself excused from this penitential practice. If for some serious reason a person must eat meat on a Friday in Lent, some other form of self-sacrifice should be performed.
- 3) Everyone who is at least 18 years of age and not yet 60 is bound also to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
 - a. On these two days of fast only one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals on these days is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.
 - b. Where health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

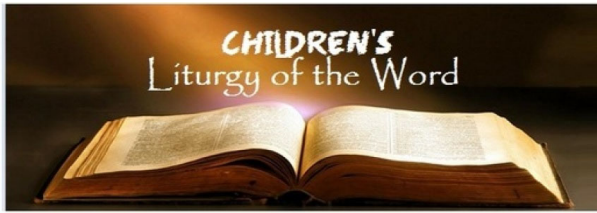

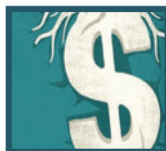

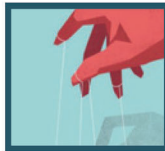
