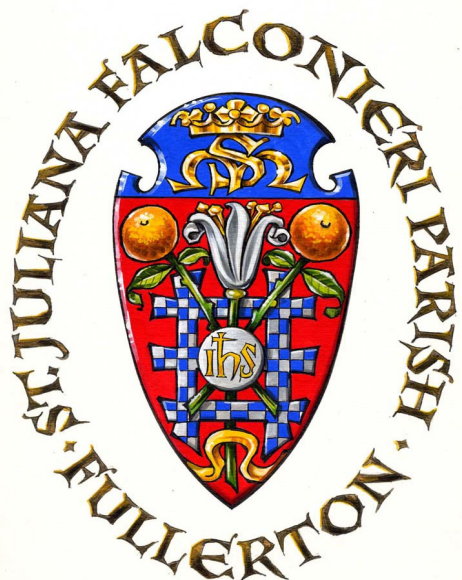

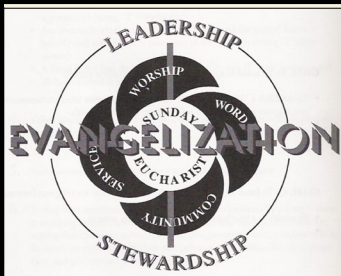
MARRIAGE ~ Couples planning to be married should contact a Priest or a Deacon at least six months before scheduling a date for their wedding.

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

Liturgically, today is the Feast of the Holy Trinity. If there is just one Sunday in the whole year when during the homily I could sit and snore, read the church bulletin, send text messages, balance my check book, or come in late, it is this Sunday. If there is just one Sunday I wish the bishop would come to deliver the homily, it's Trinity Sunday. Garrison Keillor claims that the stern Lutheran minister had difficulty with Trinity Sunday. Maybe it is the near impossibility of dealing with three—two is company and easy to multiply or divide – three is a crowded mystery.

So, here I sit; the missal, the computer, One God of Three persons, and I.

One dubious result of any computer literate student or any kind of writer is the developed talented skill to fill space with words that convey no content or coherence whatever. Formerly that skill was restricted to homilists! Faced with the Trinity, Augustine and Thomas Aquinas both admitted befuddlement and settled for analogies. All preachers risk being heretical. So, here I am, the perfect person to explicate for you the central and most fundamental doctrine of Christian theology, surrounded with easy and great possibilities for heresy, here I go.

For most of us the explanation of the Trinity is St. Patrick's analogy of the Father, Son and Spirit to the leaves of a shamrock. One stem, three distinct leaves. Neat, but hardly true. For me it was Fr. Tom Duff's religion class. Now, Duff is some kin of Fudd (Elmer Fudd), that is an important image – sit with it. Duff taught us in the splendor of his intelligence, wit and Chicago twang: "Gentlemen, today's lesson is on the Trinity. The Trinity, gentlemen, is like this – you have one source of energy, one electrical outlet, into that electrical outlet you put a three-way plug – into the three-way plug you add a lamp so that you can read the book, a toaster so that you can heat the bread, and a fan so that you can cool the body. One source of energy, three distinct functions sharing that one energy. That, gentlemen, is the Most Holy Trinity. Are there any questions?"

A better description came lately to me as I prayed in the chapel of my grammar school *alma mater*, St. Catherine's in Anaheim. There I sat looking at the magnificent stained-glass window of creation with God the Father in the center surrounded by His creation. Directly across on the mural of holy women and men is Jesus, His Son. Then on the west wall is the mosaic of Pentecost, God the Holy Spirit. They form a perfect triangle! God the Father is the creator, Jesus is the Son who saves us, and the Holy Spirit is the sanctifier. The three persons are described by what they do, their actions; create, save, sanctify.

God is a power of activity. So too is a good Dad. I know I could have gotten out of the dilemma of Trinity Sunday by talking about Father's Day. Only thing is as Church, today is Trinity Sunday – in America it is Father's Day. It's often easier to "do" Father's Day for Dad than it is to "do" Mother's Day for Mom. Dad really doesn't require much fuss, give him a new shirt and tie and he will go to work wearing your gift, a new lawn mower and he will go to work using your gift cutting the grass before he gets a chance to fire up the new bar-b-que to cook the family's meal.

A dad wears and uses his presents as a lover who cares for his beloved. For that reason, Dad is the Lord of his family and God in his home. He is the possessor of the television's remote control. HA-HA-HA

As I suggested, you would be served better if the bishop would preach on Trinity Sunday even when it happens to be Father's Day.

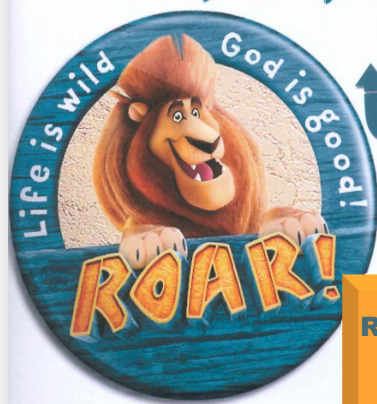

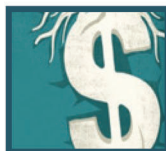

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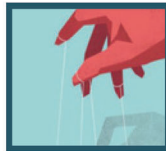
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
