A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

Well, just like that it's **Ascension Sunday!** *Ascension Thursday*, as we used to know it, is retained in the dioceses of Boston, Hartford, New York, Newark, Omaha, and Philadelphia. All other areas of the United States have transferred the Solemnity to what is the Seventh Sunday of Easter. The difference? Ascension Thursday was forty days after Easter. In some traditions the Paschal Candle was extinguished after the proclamation of the Gospel on that day. Now the Easter Candle remains lit until the final Mass on Pentecost Sunday regardless of when the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is celebrated.

I'm not sure changing the day of the week for Ascension Thursday was the wisest arrangement for the feast or the Roman Catholic community. While the move to Sunday allows the Faithful who might not attend the Thursday Mass to celebrate the Ascension, the day change is one more strut taken from Catholic culture. The Ascension really is a vital part of the calendar. The "Holy Days of Obligation" used to mark us as Catholics. Along with the Beatles let me sing: "In my life many things have changed."

Just riveting information and opinion! When we celebrate the solemnity is one thing. What might it mean and how do we live what we believe is quite different. Let's reflect more on the second option.

Imagine that you are living with the Lord, day-by-day in his own time. How long would you have walked with him? What did you hear when he spoke? What did you see when the crowds gathered and he healed? Were you there when they crucified your Lord or did you skedaddle as the apostles did? How did you feel when they took him down and placed him in the tomb? Let me now put an idea in your soul: did you feel abandoned by his death and resurrection? Did you grieve? Were you motivated to proclaim the Good News: "He Has Risen, Alleluia!?" Just how did you spend the days between that Easter morning and Pentecost? Spend time meditating on these questions; make it your table talk. Death always leaves a vacant space. During the years I taught, two students died during the academic year. The awkward situation arose: "Do I ask the student behind the now empty desk to move up, or leave it vacant?" Each time we left the space vacant until someone filled it on his own doing. Both times I heard: "Father, we just have to fill the seat." A class discussion followed: the space left an empty feeling, unresolved grief and abandonment. Some anger too. At Jesus' death, what would the disciples and Mary, the Mother of Jesus, have felt? How did they live with their real grief, emptiness, and indeed pain? Neither they nor we can dismiss the crucifixion with the claim: "Everything will be put right again." Jesus was worth their tears and weeping. With the gift of the Holy Spirit, they rose from their grief with courage to proclaim: "He is risen. He is present, Alleluia!"

Thus, Jesus did not abandon his disciples then, nor are we without him today. We might feel abandoned when we are too insensitive or selfish to recognize his presence. The Truth is, we can never really be alone. Rejoice in his love when you visit our church, be in the Real Presence of the Holy Eucharist - you are not alone. Discover Jesus as he is disguised in people all around you; disguised as those you like and don't like. Jesus is right there, disguised as those you know and do not know.

Today and right now Jesus is disguised as the one who just graduated from our St. Juliana grammar school, he's the one returning next year, he graduated from a different school but will be going to high school with you or your child. He is the successful professional, he is the everyday carpenter, he's "stinky roofer" and the "smell good plumber". He is obviously the Eagle Scout; he is hiding in the bully.

Today Jesus is present in you. When you rise from the not-yet-redeemed within you, you'll find him.

Right now, YOU can ascend beyond your faults and fears and help someone else. The Lord of Life isn't ascending in the sky like a helium balloon that got away - YOU are rising and raising others to New Life.

Don't lay low, ascend! **It's our ascension that we celebrate!** "Go and glorify the Lord by the way you live your life!" Next Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, July 9th, Fr. John Montejano who assists us on the weekends will celebrate the 25th Anniversary of his ordination. Join me in prayer and thanksgiving for Fr. John and his service to Word and Sacrament. Fr. John, we are delighted that you are with us. God bless.

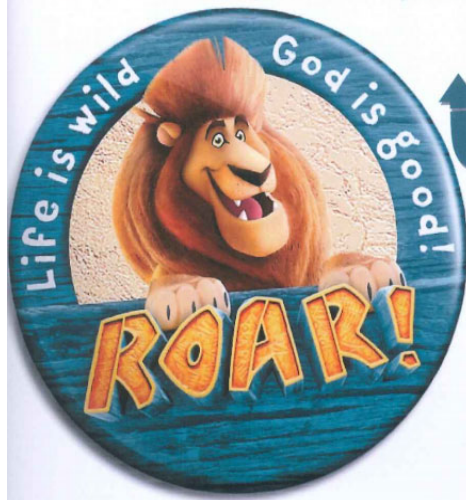

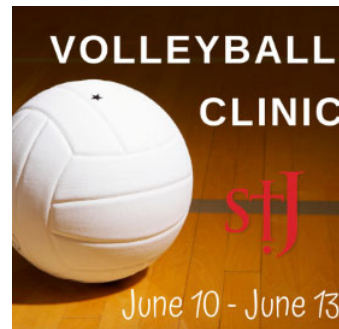

CORAZON NEWS



On Thursday & Friday, May 16th and 17th, Hilda Avila and her family received insulation and drywall in their Corazon house. The project was sponsored by an anonymous family from St. Juliana Falconeri. Hilda has been involved in Corazon for 4 years. Two years ago, she got a Corazon house. Right away, she started working towards getting a drywall project. She was on top of the waiting list to receive a complete drywall project, both walls and ceiling. She is the first in the community to receive one. This also included some electrical wiring. Besides working 30 or 40 hours a month volunteering for Corazon, Hilda also works full time at a factory making medical products for dialysis. All the manufactured supplies are exported to U.S. hospitals. For the past ten years she has been raising her family and working the night shift. She told me that in all that time there has been no openings for her for the day shift. With Corazon, Hilda enjoys working in construction, learning to sew, and getting together with others. Hilda would like to thank all those who helped make possible this project. She says that now her house will be less drafty, warmer, and cleaner.

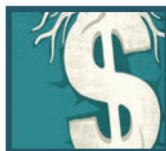

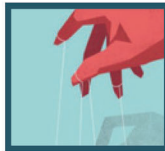
