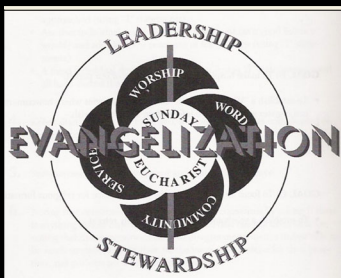

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

The Feast of the Body and Blood of Jesus - Corpus Christi, The Sacrament—Sacramento. It's a rich feast, it's our common life and our salvation. We know this as the meal of our identity, without the Holy Eucharist we are not "the Body of Christ." The feasts we have been celebrating; Pentecost, The Holy Trinity, and the one we center our attention on today are all about love.

There is nothing better than a family gathered around a table of food. Sorry folks, Italians know it best. Psst - all families know it best too, silly narcissistic Italians. No group knows it better than those who identify the meal with Jesus' own body and blood. It's the meal of bread blessed and wine poured - Jesus' own body sacrificed and Blood poured out for our salvation.

A meal shared is an act of love. "Ma, I miscounted, there are seven, not four - twelve, not nine." "Not to worry, just tell them to come. Come to my table!" And they came. They came to talk, argue, and laugh. They came to listen and remember. They came to return again.

"You satisfy the hungry heart." "Bread of life, hope for the world." "Holy and living bread, wondrous food from heaven sent...challenge us to be servants to all the poor." These are not just words to songs, they are prayers, directions on our journey to perfection.

Today the Christian family celebrates our common meal. We recall Jesus coming to us and for us. From the meal, we share in his memory - we go to live as his presence. Ain't that what we've always done? Share a meal, remember that meal, live its energy and return to the table of plenty to do it all over again.

I miss my Mother's table, especially her Sunday table. I miss friends who came to our home and table. I remember. And I celebrate who we are and what we did.

Yes, that's Eucharist! We remember, we celebrate, and we become One with the Lord and One with each other. We believe this is the Lord's feast. We believe this is the way we become holy. This meal is our "food for the journey" as St. Thomas Aquinas called it.

On this feast at our altar in our church, pause, remember, and celebrate the presence of the Lord. Believe in the Real Presence of Christ, become that presence in whichever community you are in. Give the presence of the Lord in the tabernacle worthy respect.



Fathers John Money Penny and Eddie Samaniego, SJ have been leading us in the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. They are both leaving for new assignments. Fr. Money Penny will be the pastor of St. Norbert Parish in Orange. Fr. Eddie, SJ will lead the diaconate program for the Diocese of San Diego. Fathers, thank you for being with us, consecrating our bread and our lives. God bless you in your new ministries.

CORAZON FUNDRAISER

This weekend, June 22nd and June 23rd, after all the Masses, members of the Knights of Columbus and Corazon and volunteer parishioners will be outside collecting donations to support Corazon. Parishioners at St. Juliana have been helping Corazon build, improve, and repair small houses in Tijuana, Mexico for more than 20 years. Your past and ongoing generosity is greatly appreciated by the carefully chosen recipients.

This year our goal is to raise \$4000 to buy materials to sponsor 2 complete drywall and insulation projects, and 3 roof repairs, thus helping 5 needy families. The labor is done by Mexicans in the Corazon community. *Any donation to meet this goal will be welcome.*

Besides construction projects, Corazon offers scholarships to hardworking students of Corazon community members. Corazon parents, who frequently have a third to sixth grade education, are able to give their children the opportunity to finish high school, or even go on to vocational school, or college with the support they receive through Corazon scholarships.

Donations to the scholarship fund will also be accepted.

Here is an article from one of Corazon's recent projects:

Lupe and Armin and their 4 children live in Tijuana in a part of town converted from a dump. Their small piece of land is located up a steep partly paved road. On May 30 and 31, they received insulation and drywall in their Corazon house. First, we worked on some re-wiring. Then we worked to build an attic and screens for ventilation, before installing the insulation and drywall on the walls and ceiling. Several people from the nearby community joined to help. For many, it was the first time working on such a project. Cesar was particularly interested in learning about electrical skills and is inspired to learn more. Alfredo had never used a box cutter knife before to cut drywall and decided to perfect that skill, while others were interested in learning to measure parallelograms and triangles in the English system. Marcos mastered using the drywall lift to place drywall on the ceiling, while other workers got to use a staple gun to attach the insulation, and screw-guns to fasten the drywall in place. Lupe and her friends made us a wonderful lunch. Armin and the two older children, age 22 and 20 were working at their jobs in a t-shirt factory, and as waiters in restaurants. The two younger boys age 12 and 14 go to school on Corazon scholarships. This project, sponsored by a family from St. Juliana, will greatly enhance the quality of life for Lupe's family, plus, it has already given skills and experience for the people who helped from the local community. 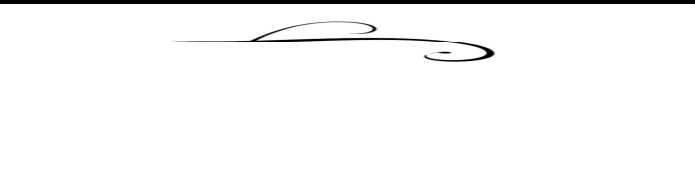

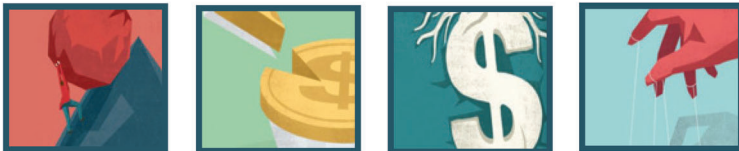
