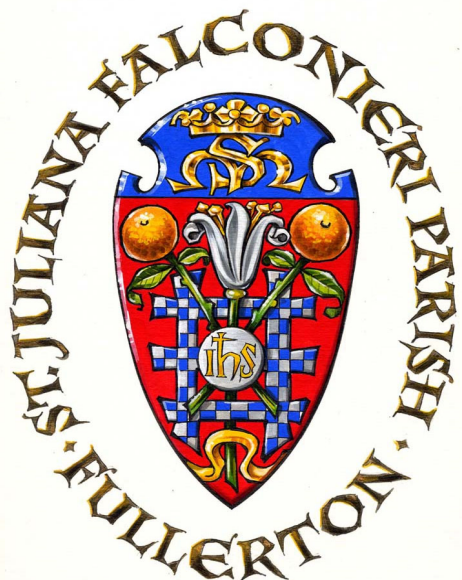

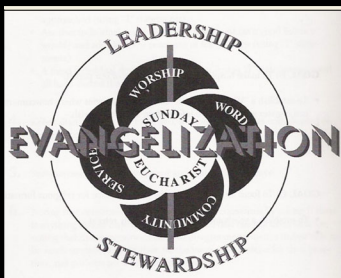
MARRIAGE ~ Couples planning to be married should contact a Priest or a Deacon at least six months before scheduling a date for their wedding.

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

Pentecost is an odd word. We Christians “borrowed” it from the Jews and used it for the initiation of our Church. It celebrates the 50th day after the Passover when Moses returned from Sinai with a radiant face after encountering Yahweh. In the Catholic Christian Tradition, today is the 50th day after Easter when Jesus went fearlessly through the desert of death and emerged more real, more alive than any human being could ever have hope to be. So it is our time as Church to accept our mission to emerge into the world ablaze with the enlivening Spirit of God. Jesus’ breath, the life-giving gift of the Holy Spirit, is now embodied in us. That gift is courage.

Graduation is a commonly used word. It brings joy. Commencement is a more difficult word. It signifies the beginning, the initiation, of a new way of living, especially after receiving some instruction or finishing a degree program. Those chosen by the Lord were his disciples, another strange word meaning students. As they completed their instruction at the first ever Christian school, with the best ever teacher, Jesus sent them out into the world, to be where he could not go, with the purpose of extending the Good News to everyone who has ears to listen. With courage they went forth to proclaim: “Jesus is Lord.”

The disciples – which includes each of us- are both taught and sent forth to teach all nations the secret that Jesus is Lord. Today those first disciples courageously stood up to be counted. Fearlessly they proclaimed “Jesus is Lord” and that message frees all who hear it from sin and death; the confessional belief “Jesus is Lord” is belief in the Kingdom which lasts forever. It’s the first and last message of all Christian education.

All Catholic school students, whether from formal Catholic school or a variety of faith formation classes including Confirmation, are once again commissioned as apostles –sent forth to commence a new life of practicing what was learned from religious teachers – those dreaded despots – who are no longer with them. What will measure the success of the Catholic school graduate? What will make the world know of the presence of the Catholic school graduate? What will make neighborhoods and businesses realize that a Catholic school graduate lives next door or works in the next office? Will crime rates go down, property value go up and production increase? Most likely evidence will not come from SAT scores, football or fund-raising, income checks, net worth, size of home, number of digital screens, or make and model of any automobile. Rather, the Catholic education and celebration of the sacraments received will be successful when their graduates imitate those first disciples and proclaim “Good News” to all people – if our graduates don’t realize their responsibility to build up the next generation of church our schools are no more successful than any school. In fact, the school failed in its mission and it took the kids inheritance in the process. Right? The Catholic school accepts disciples and it graduates apostles or it fails in its purpose.

Listen to voices that offer guidance. Hear Helen Ready belt out in full voice: “I am woman! Hear me roar!” or Mother Teresa of Calcutta, a woman as fragile as an eggshell and yet as unstoppable as a runaway train. Oprah Winfrey, a true Cinderella from a farm in Mississippi now an influential woman. Dorothy Day and a whole group of other tigers who refuse to button up no matter what the cost of humiliation or exploitation. Listen to the voice of courage.

Today we are encouraged to be so spirit-filled that we can do no other than rise from worship and say “YES” – I am Christian. Hear me roar, in numbers too big to ignore! “Spirit of the living God fall afresh on us.” Give us courage to be Christians. Right now.

Some final work remains on the entry project. The windows of Jesus and Mary have been removed to be re-framed. Their images should have been in the center not the lower portion of the rectangular frame. Some other touch up work will be completed soon. Thank you for your patience.
