A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



Our first reading, I'm not fond of today's Gospel lesson. Fair enough, I've said: "If the Gospel does not UN-nerve you, you aren't reading the Gospel." Here's the reason why I am arguing with it today.

Here's my issue: "God of the Pounce" – Be prepared! God will come and pounce on you, at a moment you least expect. Look out! I don't like that God. I don't like that Santa Claus.

When I was a school boy at St. Catherine's in Anaheim, the good sisters had us convinced that the speaker up high in the corner of the room, which looked like a mouth, was an ear. That mitered wooden box humorously looked like it had facial features. Because "sister said" it was an ear, we believed her. She convincingly told us that all the noise we made in our classroom would be listened to by sister principal in her office. When we were acting badly, she will come at an unknown time! In fear we believed and obeyed. Sister Pounce was real.

Then that day came, November 22, 1963 – the ear spoke. It told us: "President Kennedy has been shot and is mortally wounded. All teachers are to take their students to the chapel immediately." I understood "shot", I didn't understand "mortally wounded", and I couldn't understand how that ear could turn into a mouth.

The speaker never was an ear. It could not function that way. Neither does God.

God is made small when we turn Him into what He is not. A policeman hiding behind an obstruction so he can't be noticed yet ready to pounce on an offender – is not God. A stage director, putting words in our mouths and directing our every move – is not God. God is love. Fear is not love.

Jesus forgave sinners without asking "what did you do and how many times did you do it?" He is not a CPA balancing sins with a penance column if the sinner could be redeemed.

God is not lurking ready to destroy the sinner. Jesus told the "town sinner" – "I do not condemn you, go and sin no more." To the tax-collector sinner Jesus said: "I mean to stay at your house tonight." To the fearful Jesus says: "Peace be with you."

Today, prepare a peaceful place for Jesus in your "inner room."

Paranoia is not from God. The game of "got cha" will not make you holy. God is transfiguring us into the likeness of Jesus. He raised up Jesus. He wants to raise us up, not beat us down. He won't pounce on us, love doesn't do that.

Listen to God speaking: "Come and pray. Come and meet me and my Son. Come and be guided by our Holy Spirit." Time spent in prayer will prepare us to be "faithful and prudent stewards" ready for what is unexpected. Therefore, spend some time with Jesus in the church. If not immediately, when?

Suddenly my argument with the Gospel has lifted. Time with God is like that.

Thank you, all of you, who offered hospitality to Fr. Monty Williams, SJ. Thank you, all of you, who attended our Sunday *Family, Food, and Faith Formation* - who shared a meal and a talk with the community. I hope you think Fr. Monty was as awesome as I do. His books include: *Stepping into Mystery*, *The Gift of Spiritual Intimacy*, *The Way of the Faithful*, *Finding God in the Dark I and II*. Amazon.com has many – Novalis.ca has each one.
