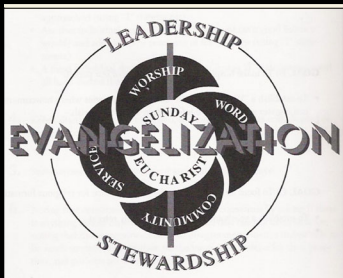

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



Focus-Focus-FOCUS

Some years ago I attended an in-service day to teach the faculty some new tricks. The leader got our attention by saying: “Focus, focus, focus” as she guided her right and left index fingers toward each other. Frankly, that’s about all I recall of the day. I’ve practiced the technique ever since!

So, **FOCUS, FOCUS, FOCUS** – what’s Fr. Mike up to with FOCUS?

Formed “missionary disciples” FOCUS (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) was established in 1998 by Mr. Curtis Martin to evangelize college students in their Catholic faith. Bishop Vann invited FOCUS into the Diocese of Orange soon after his arrival in 2012. Note: The mission is toward Catholic students, not students at Catholic universities – I too got it wrong! FOCUS is on the Cal State University Fullerton Campus where it brings the Person and Gospel of Jesus to Catholic students who attend it. Today, FOCUS missionaries are on more than 170 college campuses in five countries, primarily in the USA. They serve, now with St. Juliana, eight parishes.

This is the time of “New Evangelization.” Church leaders are offered a variety of programs which assist parish communities in renewing the Good News of the Gospel which will engage the lives of parishioners. I have talked with pastors, studied a variety of programs, and prayed: “How am I, as pastor, to enhance the good work already begun at this parish of St. Juliana in 2019 and beyond?” Meaningful programs such as “Renew” brought life in the past. Current programs; “Alpha” or “Christ Renews His Church” and the like are serving parishes in our diocese today. I’ve concluded that FOCUS is the best for this parish. Why shouldn’t you have the best?

Here’s the deal: Wisely, over several years and costing millions of dollars, you have enhanced the facilities of St. Juliana. Now it’s time to do the ministry of “New Evangelization”; that is to spend resources on yourselves as God’s Chosen people to renew and engage the faith life of the community.

It’s your joyful faith that I as your pastor desire to develop with God’s help. You come through our doors because you believe in Jesus and this community is your address. It’s the charism of St. Juliana – **community** (she founded the community of Servite Sisters), **Eucharist** (she was dedicated to it, so much so that when she could no longer swallow, the Host left its mark on her religious habit), and **faith formation** (she was the niece of St. Alexis Falconieri one of the Seven Founders of the Servite Order, Alexis was in charge of formation) that shapes our parish.

With the help of Adam Ybarra, our FOCUS missionary, it is my hope that we strengthen our Catholic community. Let us be united as the St. Juliana Parish which includes St. Juliana Grammar School as one community for the Lord. *“It’s just better when we’re together”* – thanks Jack Johnson for the song.

Through friendship, hospitality, Bible study, prayer groups, and community building fun, Adam Ybarra will be assisting all of us to form a lasting relationship with one another and with Jesus Christ. Our goal is to know and live the Gospel more fully, faithfully, joyfully and to pray fervently. Evangelization is the joy of every missionary – that’s why they do it! That’s just one reason why I like FOCUS so much. Reaching our goal is my prayer. Get to know Adam and the excitement FOCUS brings to our community as we know, love, and serve Jesus Christ more deeply. *(See page five of this bulletin for an article from Adam Ybarra.)*

A NOTE FROM OUR FOCUS MISSIONARY, ADAM YBARRA



Most people will ask, what's a missionary doing at a parish in Southern California? Aren't missionaries serving in third-world countries or traveling abroad to deliver Bibles in starving countries?

19 years ago, I was asking myself the same question as FOCUS was becoming more of a reality in Lincoln, Nebraska. FOCUS had just established programs at Benedictine College in

Kansas and at the University of Northern Colorado. The University of Nebraska would be the next post for FOCUS. It's mission, to bring the Gospel message of Jesus Christ and His Church to the one of the most hostile environments - the college campus.

Fast forward 17 years and I found myself in a U-Haul moving truck (car on a dolly) traveling west to Orange, California. I had just completed my 3rd year helping FOCUS to execute our large group events and staff trainings, but the Lord had rekindled this spark in my heart to be on mission in a new way. In prayer I would hear my answer, "Go west!" I don't think that you can get much further away from Lincoln than Orange County! I was invited to join a team to help navigate a new arm within the FOCUS apostolate; parish outreach.

As we researched the success FOCUS has had in the past 20 years, the question was becoming more and more evident. "Where are all of these students going to land once they graduate?" Now, FOCUS has always had and will continue to have as its primary effort being the college campus. It's the most pivotal arena that influences the rest of the world. But what about the parishes where they land? What if we could begin to overlay the FOCUS model of win-build-send accompanied with teaching people about Divine intimacy, authentic friendship and clarity and conviction for spiritual multiplication? What kind of impact would that have?? Parish Outreach became a reality. We are still new at this. In fact, St. Juliana is one of EIGHT parishes in the United States that have agreed to partner with FOCUS in the parish.

My hope and time here at St. Juliana will be spent running alongside current ministries and helping Father Mike to create one parish and one heartbeat of St. Juliana. I'll be running weekly Bible studies; teaching people how to know and share their faith; spending time with the staff of the parish and school; taking people to Phoenix in January for our annual conference; inviting you to come on a mission trip with me to Mexico City in October - basically getting involved in the life of an already vibrant parish.

I'm a huge sports fan and a self-proclaimed foodie and I'm excited for the parish Fall Festival!
