### A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



By definition and job description, a prophet is synonymous with teacher. Specifically, in the religious sense the prophet teaches the will of God. God is transparent in the person of the prophet, God and the prophet have achieved divine intimacy. This friendship inspires the prophet to lead others toward true belief and right action. As such the *status quo* of a community is challenged. Think of the prophets of the Old Testament; Isaiah or Jeremiah. St. Francis, St. Juliana, Martin Luther, St. Frances “Mother” Cabrini, St. John XXIII, St. John Paul II, among others come quickly to mind too.

In the secular sense, a prophet is an inspired teacher, an oracle who directs people to live more fully, offering new hope. Minds turn toward Socrates, Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King Jr., Dorothy Day, various writers C.S. Lewis, G. K. Chesterton, Flannery O’Connor, Mark Twain, William Faulkner, and others of the great canon of literature. In real life they were or are the teacher or athletic coach, or advisor to whom you owe a debt of gratitude. They came as pure gift into your life.

Many prophets, religious and secular, had enemies who killed them: “let us kill the just one who is obnoxious to us.” (see Wisdom 2:12). They were “rabble rousers” who upset the *status quo*.

As another school year opens, I hope students will hear a prophet’s voice in their teachers and school lessons especially in the humanities. It is also my desire that students will challenge the *status quo* with their newly found Truth. The classroom ought to be a place where previously un-challenged certitudes are questioned, where direction is given when there is a fork in the road, and where learners take possession of their lives.

A young man once approached Jesus and asked him what was necessary for salvation. Jesus asked him how he was living his life. The man replied: “I keep the commandments.” Jesus then said: “If you wish to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.” (see Matthew 19:16-22) The fellow went away sad. Although he was doing what was required by law, he did not possess knowledge of God, he was not a disciple. Christian education is the challenge to live as a disciple of Jesus.

This school year, may each of us, young and old, recognize that we will always be learners, hearers of the word, and renew ourselves as disciples of Jesus and good citizens of the State. Psst: this can be accomplished through students and their teachers!

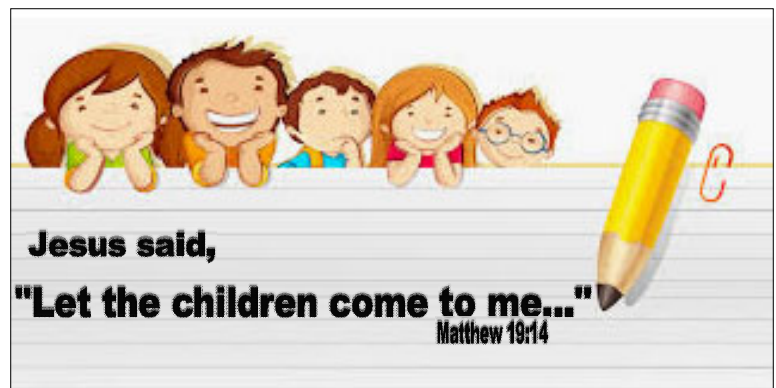
Yes, this school year may our school teachers be recognized as prophets, elders leading their students as disciples to experience life grounded in a new hope to live authentically. Would that each lesson taught lead all people to perfection, which means to God.

Engage students to share their classroom lessons. Such actions will encourage family life! See if some *status quo* isn’t upset and some certitudes challenged.



This school year, may learning lead to knowledge of God and knowledge of God lead to friendship with Jesus. This school year, may the Holy Spirit of God enlighten minds and encourage the right action of a prophet.

The will of God will prevail. His Truth will set us free.
