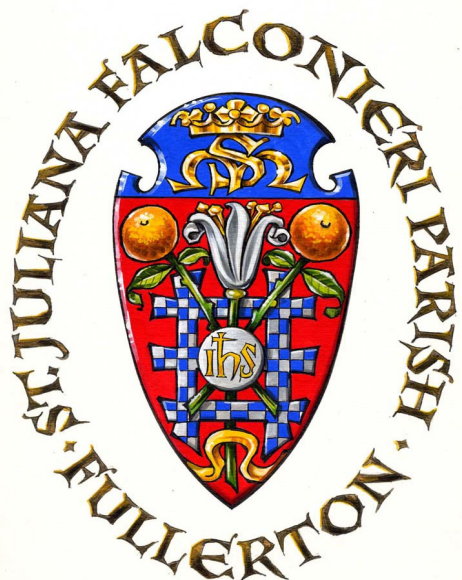

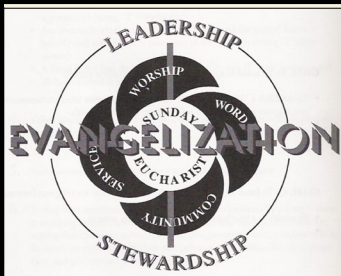
MARRIAGE ~ Couples planning to be married should contact a Priest or a Deacon at least six months before scheduling a date for their wedding.

A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

Re-read and pray with the today's Gospel lesson. "On a Sabbath Jesus went to dine at the home of one of the leading Pharisees, and the people there were observing him carefully." Yeah, we have been there. At the home of someone who accepted us and allowed us to be who we are, as a guest comfortable in their home. AND at the home of someone who accepted us to observed us; to critique and gossip about us.

But, did you ever corrected the host as Jesus does today? Not if you want the friendship to last!

How do you extend hospitality? How do you accept hospitality? The door swings both ways.

It's always a bit humbling to be invited to the home of another family. Upon arrival, do I help or sit and talk? That's the Martha and Mary lesson. As host, do I observe as if to gather data about my guest's worthiness to be in my home?

Hospitality is a virtue. God is always hospitable, as Creator He fashioned the Garden home of our first parents. Everything we would ever need or want was in that utopian Garden. Then zingo by disobedience we were exiled. Yet even in our exile, God's hospitality is everywhere. Right now our relationship with nature, the care of creation, is a central part in our lives. It is the spirituality of St. Francis.

Yet, consider this. What sort of hospitality did Jesus experience? Life was rough from birth; he was born into an inhospitable world in a manger. His parents were refused shelter. Life never got much easier. As he grew he was not accepted by his temple.

Jesus demonstrates the hospitality he does not receive. He multiplies loaves and fishes at the moment his disciples want to dismiss the crowds. He extends banquet invitations to sinners. He keeps a wedding feast from ending by turning water into wine.

If that is not enough, as his death came close, at a final meal he became the quintessential host. At that meal he washed feet and offered himself. Finally, on the cross he saw that the disciple John and his Mother Mary would care for one another.

Why is hospitality so important? For no other reason that it simply recognizes that Jesus is the guest coming through our door, eating at our table, walking and talking with us.

Hospitality is itself a gift. And it is the recognition of a gift. It is God saying I am attentive to you. Not much more can make us happier than experiencing and extending the gift of life with others. It is hospitality that says: "You are not alone". Through hospitality, both the host and the guest are graced.

Practice and receive hospitality. It will bring pleasure to all.
