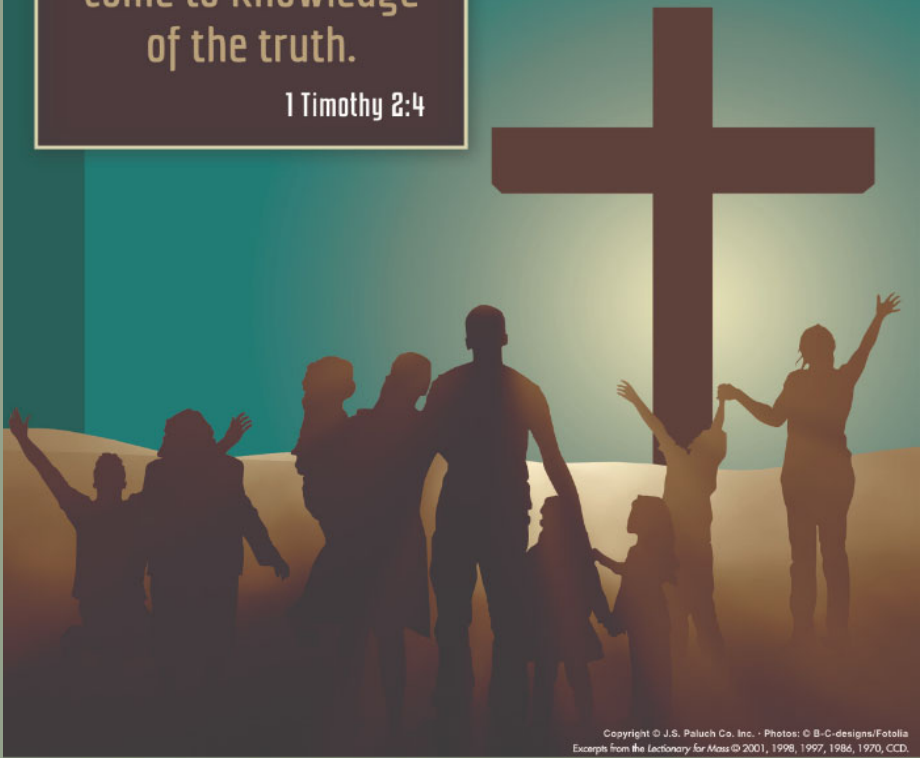

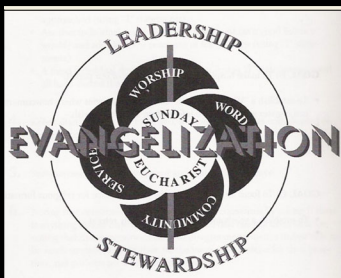

## A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M



Hey, did you ever cheat on your golf score? The card that no one really sees or places great credibility in? Did you do it more than once? Certainly, I would go not broke if I bet you rationalize your behavior with thusly: “I’m an honest person. I cheat only when I have a need and opportunity – like on my income tax – golf score – or not telling the teacher I have fewer points on my test, or ... A **little** cheating now and again doesn’t make me a bad person. It’s called ‘beating the system’ which ya just gotta do. Frankly, my dear, it is the best lesson I learned in school.” Psst: here’s a principle: “As grows the twig, so grows the tree.” Most of our faults are unarguably petty, but if you accumulate enough of them, they become your identity. And the sad thing is their pettiness seems to absolve sin rather than embarrass the sinner. Psst: reflect on today’s Gospel: “The person who is trustworthy in **small** matters is also trustworthy in great ones. If you are dishonest in small matters, you are dishonest in great ones.” Make you uneasy? If the Gospel doesn’t un-nerve you, you aren’t reading the Gospel.

Once, while I was teaching, I participated on a faculty committee to form a policy for disciplining cheaters. While the policy established a “hierarchy of consequences” for cheating, the important part of the policy was, so I believed, not in punishing cheaters but forming the virtues of honesty and integrity in our students. I wrote the moral preamble while I argued over the punitive measures. Just after the policy was promulgated, I caught two students cheating on a major test. One was a blue chip athlete in season while the other was a random student who supplied the answers. The students knew they were cheating and that I caught them, so did the administration. The policy had stated consequences for the offense.

I had them meet me after school. Instead of following the hand book I set up a moral case, I told the students that they were married and had young children. They held a position in a corporation which demanded that they would travel often and be away from their wives and children. Will they remain faithful to their marriage vows or not? Here’s the point: If you cheat on something so insignificant as a high school religion test, what will you do in “white knuckle moments?” My students were to remain in the classroom and write an essay on the importance of integrity; my direction was to make it personal and address it to your wife. The papers were read by me for content, coherence, and composition. After a time, the essays fulfilled the assignment. Then I told the students to read that personal writing aloud to each other and me. I figured my measure was suitable for the crime and a better teaching tool than keeping the rule that would have suspended them during the spring quarter. Read; sun tan for prom!

The administration was upset that I violated, cheated, the rules. I rationalized my action in many ways. I still contend it was important to teach two high school seniors that the way they deal habitually today with small problems is a pretty good indicator of how they’ll deal with their future spouse, their children, their lifetime jobs.

We all claim to be people of good virtue, yet not a few of us tell ourselves lies about ourselves—and worse, believe them. The most basic virtue is clear-eyed honesty—with yourself—about yourself. It’s surely the most elusive.

**PENNIES FROM HEAVEN COLLECTION RESULTS**

Of the 435 baby bottles that went out in August, 285 were returned and the total of money that was collected was 7,386.61.  
\$151.65 was kept out to reimburse for the cost of 12 doz. extra baby bottles needed.  
So the total of the check sent to the Diocese of Orange office of Respect Life was \$7,234.96.

There were 150 bottles not returned, so just hold onto them and return them for the collection next August (hopefully full).

The La Habra Life Center Clinic is especially grateful for these extra funds that the Pennies From Heaven Collection provides to their ministry. They are now operating as a medical clinic as well as doing counseling, testing referrals and providing baby supplies. Also its Medical Director and Nurse have joined the Abortion Pill Reversal Health Care Team and that service is now available at the La Habra Life Center.

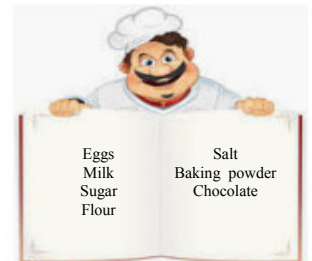
## Donated Cakes and Desserts NEW THIS YEAR - please read



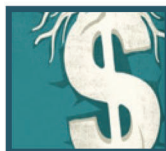

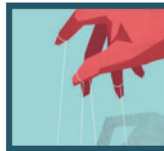
