



#### A NOTE FROM FR. MIKE PONTARELLI, O.S.M

I'll bet good money that you are ready to ask the question: "But Faaaather, why did Jesus have to be baptized?" Or "But Faaaather, why was Jesus baptized?" So did I! But I never did. I was afraid that I would expose myself as being either ignorant or not strong enough with belief. Further, I did not hear the usual response, "Mike, it's a mystery, there is no further explanation. Next question, please!"

Accept the thundering voice of the heavens toward Jesus as being true: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased." And all eyes must have looked at Jesus. Fingers pointed no longer to John the Baptist but to Jesus. John realized he was simply

the warm-up act. Minds understood and hearts were warmed by the presence of Jesus. Ears heard the Good News of Salvation. People were moved to action. Finally, Jesus somehow came into a new self-realization of who he is and what he is and how he will fit into salvation history.

Because we were baptized, that same voice called us – certainly, we are sons and daughters of God our Father. With the grace of baptism, we are grafted into the Trinity Family. We can no longer be silent about our identity. As Jesus was told, so are we being who we are and how we fit into God's plan. The certain challenge of each baptized Christian is to bring the Good News of the Kingdom of God to all people, offering everyone a new hope, the fullness of life.

You fit in the Kingdom of God as a prophet. Your joy is complete when you live your life fully as a member of the Kingdom of God and teach others the joy of being God's chosen ones! No matter what anyone says of you; You have been chosen by God as a missionary disciple.


Many people question why Jesus had to be baptized. Be concerned instead with this question: "How do you



### MASS COUNTS AND NATIONAL CENSUS 2020 INFO

During the month of October, we take a special count of Mass attendance for parish and diocesan records. Did you know that this year is Census 2020 during which the U.S. takes it's constitutionally mandated count? The U.S. Bishops have reminded us: "Our country conducts a Census every ten years to count the number of men, women and children residing in the United States. Census data helps direct more than \$800 billion annually to key programs designed to advance the common good, strengthen families and reduce poverty. The Catholic Church and other service providers rely on the national Census to provide an accurate count in order to effectively serve those in need."

You can make a difference in the places we live, work, and worship. The immersive showcase features museum quality, near-lifesize reproductions of the iconic master's 34 frescos that adorn the Sistine Chapel in the Vatican.


