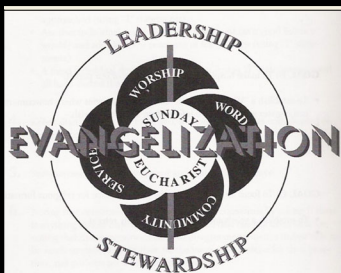

Greetings All

I am making decisions for all of us based on the guidelines of the Diocese, government, reliable data, and consultation with a variety of professionals.. Please manage expectations of what is being done and how you will know about it! The best plans of the morning change by the afternoon. I know you are supporting us; I appreciate your trust, thank you.

As I write this on Wednesday, March 18 in the morning, I can tell you that daily Mass is live streamed at 6:30AM and Sunday at 9:00 with some singing. These are recorded and you can find them on YOUTUBE.com – St Juliana Falconieri Church Live Stream. At the Mass, information will be given to you. **PLEASE WATCH THE RECORDED**

**MASS, you don't have to see it at live, it is recorded and can be watched for eternity, like your favorite television re-runs!** When you watch the Mass and pray it –don't laugh too hard and my recorded goofs! I'm not the perfectionist Bishop Barron is! He has a recorded Mass and links to other Masses.

You might believe “social media” to be obnoxious and a horrendous waste of time. However, you will find valuable church information on Facebook at St Juliana Falconieri Catholic Community and on Twitter at St. Juliana Church & School. [Stjulianachurch.org](http://Stjulianachurch.org) is our website, please consult that. The telephone, 714.879.1965 will have information which will be change as needed. It's a limited recording.

Some religious education and confirmation classes will be posted soon. Bible study information will also be available electronically. I am grateful to Mr. Gamboa and Mr. Ybarra for their ministry with us.

Confessions will be heard on Saturday beginning at 3:30 in the Children's Chapel. That space will allow both privacy and “social distance.” Please remain at “social distance” in the church or outside as the weather permits. Consult the media sites above for more confession dates and times during the week.

**Of what was told you last week at Mass, please remember this from Bishop Vann:**

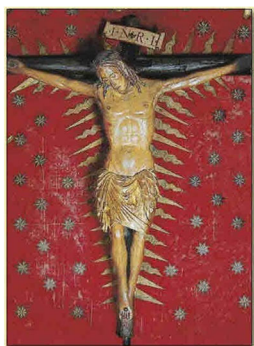
**Until further notice, Bishop Vann hereby dispenses from the obligation to participate in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation (cf. canons 85, 87 §1, 90 §1 and 1247 of the 1983 Code of Canon Law). Avail yourselves to a livestreamed services if possible. The faithful are to keep in mind their duty to continue to assist with financial support of the Church, in accordance with canons 222 §1 and 1261 of the same Code of Canon Law, and should consider giving electronically via their parish website or mailing a check to their parish.**

**Note carefully what this means: you miss attending Mass personally without sin for as long as Mass is suspended. Please continue your obligation to contribute to the support of the parish, which will have on-going bills and salaries to pay. All Mass intentions are being honored.**

Often people are out walking their dogs, walking themselves, healthy brats are jogging, and riding bicycles. Many are looking for a place of peace which is offered by the park across the street. I have decided, until further notice, to keep the church open around the clock. Please keep “social distance” when in it. The front doors open and lock via a timer. If the front doors are locked, side doors should be open. I hope that offers some peace and calm.

The Blessed Miraculous Crucifix Venerated in the Church of San Marcello al Corso in Rome. A ministry of the Servite Order.

This crucifix was the object of profound veneration by the faithful of Rome since 1519 when it was miraculously undamaged in a great fire. In 1522, when carried through all quarters of Rome in procession, the end of the Pest (see below) was attributed to it and this prodigious

event gave origin to the Archconfraternity of the Blessed Crucifix. The miraculous image during the Holy Years was carried in procession to the Vatican Basilica was displayed here for the veneration of the faithful.

During the night between the 22nd and 23rd May 1519, a terrible fire destroyed the antique church, burying a patrimony of history and art amongst the ruins. Parts of the perimeter were saved, a few columns, a few frescoes and the wooden cross remained miraculously undamaged that is still venerated today.

The “antique” wooden Cross that rises above the altar and the glass lamp that burned in front of it were miraculously saved amongst the ruins of the church.

This miraculous event profoundly moved the Romans, so much so that a large group of faithful started to meet in one of the rooms in the adjacent convent where the venerated effigy was temporarily displayed, thereby giving origin to the special cult that from Rome diffused throughout the world and that is still alive today.

**The Plague of 1522:** Three years after this extraordinary event, a serious epidemic of “the Pest” (Plague) spread throughout the city. It was Raimondo Vich, the Spanish titular Cardinal of San Marcello, to implore for divine grace, promoting a solemn, penitential procession in that year in which participated all categories of persons: the clergy, religious people, nobles, cavaliers, men, women, old folk and children who “in bare feet and covered in ashes in a single and high voice, interrupted only by the sobs and sighs of those that accompanied them, shouted: “mercy Blessed Crucifix”.

During this procession that lasted 16 days, the Blessed Crucifix was positioned on top of a carrier and carried shoulder high through various quarters of Rome and even arrived at the Basilica of Saint Peter. The chroniclers of the époque confirmed that the Pest ceased where the procession passed in the various quarters. Following this second miraculous event, Cardinal Vich and many noble Romans came together determined to found a Company in the name of the Blessed Crucifix that was eventually erected canonically to Confraternity and its statutes were approved by Clemente VII on the 28th May 1526.

This crucifix is traditionally brought to St. Peter’s on Jubilee Years for the Solemn Ceremony of Good Friday.

Thus, Pope Francis made a special visit to San Marcello, a church of the Servites during the COVID-19 crisis.
