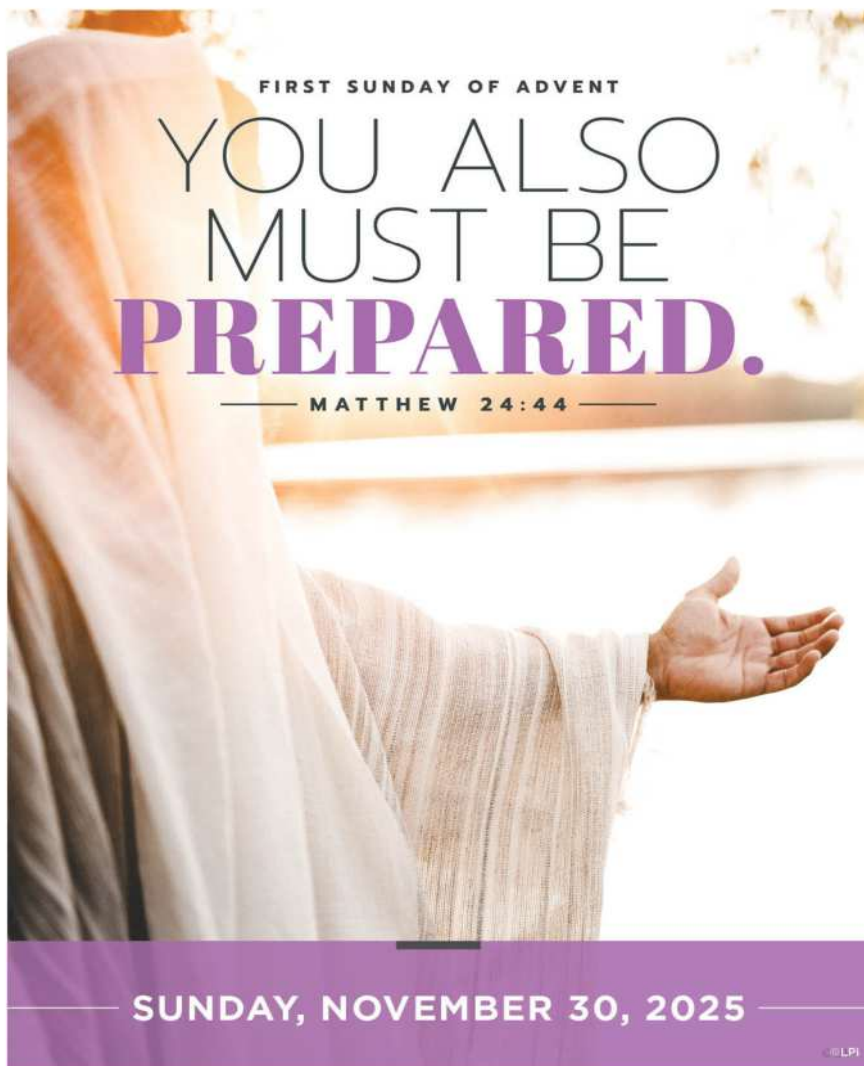

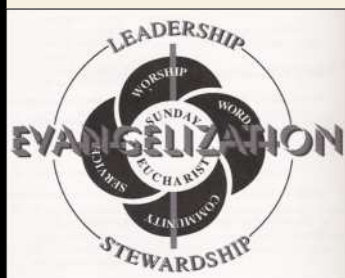

Message from Fr. Mike

Sometimes it's best to start at the end – Listen once more to the last line of today's Gospel; "By your perseverance you will secure your lives." At the end of each fiscal year, every pastor must make a report, written or spoken, to his parish. This talk is commonly referred to as "The Sermon on the Amount!" Today, it's also a topic and talk that makes me more than a little bit nervous. Frankly, I would rather explain why airplanes fly like arrows but fruit flies like bananas.

Quickly to the point: In plain language during the past year, our Parish Finance Council noticed that the ordinary income of the parish is not paying ordinary expenses and that extra-ordinary income, various unexpected donations: "Pennies from heaven" were not materializing. The past year end financial report shows our parish to be in deficit of \$192,000.

Okay, take a deep breath. 42% of the budget is salaries for a small office staff, (salary) expenses for the liturgy and faith formation and one priest. To save money some of our staff are part time, not all claim benefits. Except for the priest, salaries are paid according to the fixed and standard wages of the State of California. On the priest side, we budgeted for one full time and one part time priest (should one be assigned), yet we spend only for one full time priest. The priests who supply Sunday Masses each receive a stipend for the Masses they celebrate. Over-all expenses are underbudget but remember, included is the half salary for a priest.

Long ago and emphasized during COVID, I believed we should lead by the charism of St. Juliana, our patroness. The emphasis would be on funding community, liturgy, and faith formation experiences. I also realized that the weekly donations will not be sufficient for community, liturgy, and faith formation expenses. Therefore, the annual PSA rebates are used to fund these necessary expenses. To date, we have just reached our Diocesan PSA goal, with a modest rebate of \$1,000 soon to be received. Please contribute to the PSA drive, the rebate is now returned to our own parish. Separate from the PSA rebate, from the Diocese of Orange we receive a grant of \$22,000 toward youth ministry expenses. In charitable outreach, \$49,600 was collected for St. Vincent De Paul. \$20,000 was given to St. Anthony Claret Parish, an Anaheim Catholic community in need of assistance. The parish contributed \$56,000 to fund St. Juliana Parish Grammar School.

How did we end with a deficit? For the past few years, we have been receiving various COVID funds which padded the income. Our ordinary collection has been diminishing. We have experienced the deaths of many of the founding elders of our community. God shows no partiality; some younger ones have also died. Some of parishioners are in the care of their adult children or are residing at senior care facilities.

So, what is the remedy? The Finance Council asked Mr. Curtis Wesseln to explore professional offertory enhancement programs. After hearing the presentation of one, which would include testimonial talks from various parishioners, asking each you to write sacrificial offering commitment pledge cards along with receiving mailings and a company's cost for the services – we asked: "Why not try it ourselves? Let's present the need for an offertory increase to our community. Because they will respond."

Today I'm taking a risk – a calculated risk - that if I speak to you, you will respond. If the next generation, the adult children and newer members of the community, will prayerfully consider your regular contributions to St. Juliana you will assure the continuation of the ministry begun here sixty years ago. Please plan your offering to be a sacrificial offering for the on-going ministry of St. Juliana Parish.

As many non-profit organizations set aside a special "Day of Giving" consider an extra donation. Please consider a special day of giving to St. Juliana Parish -Thanksgiving Weekend, Christmas, New Years, Epiphany, any day you make special will be special to St. Juliana. If you wish, designate your gift for liturgy or faith formation.

If you already donate electronically, prayerfully consider increasing your donation if that is possible for you.

There is no admission fee to our liturgies where the community participates in splendid liturgical music. There is no tuition where the community hears thoughtful instruction on the Word of God and our common faith. There is no menu price for the Food of Eternal Life you receive from the Altar Table. Just a free-will donation. Can you give better?

Some years ago, when we were younger and concluding the capital campaign for the parish center debt, I likened St. Juliana Parish as "the little engine that could". In size we are a small parish, other parishes are much larger, yet we do great things when together we care for the St. Juliana community. Being smaller places an additional burden on each of us, the costs are divided among fewer parishioners. Please, prayerfully consider your contribution. If it is possible for you to increase your sacrificial gift, bless you. If you can begin to contribute, bless you. If you pray with and for us and are part of the community, bless you. It has always been easy for me to thank you and to tell you that you are a good and generous community, even when the community would need more from you. You are a good and generous community, and today we do need more from you.

Let's re-cap from today's Gospel: "By your perseverance, you will secure your lives – and add the life of this faith community."

Secondly, I report that the finances of the school are above good. This good report comes as the result of the reception of COVID funding and an endowment that was given to the school. This beneficial year has helped to replenish the savings used in the recent past years when there was an end-of-year deficit. It would be nice to enroll more students. If you know of anyone who is looking for a good Roman Catholic Parish Grammar School, please arrange for a tour of our school.

Third, some maintenance issues. The perimeter fence, all asphalt surfaces, and gym floor are all needing replacement. The Diocese of Orange has been an enormous help to principal Dr. Terri Puccini, business manager Mr. Esteban Jimenez and me. With the help of the Diocese a grant proposal was written for a state funded security fence. Because of that grant writing we received a grant of \$245,000 - free money – from the State of California for a new **security** fence. It will be fabricated in rot iron and will replace the existing chain link fence. There will be modifications to the existing fence.

Because it is a "**security fence**" it will be six feet tall. Also, we must secure the south-east (Melody Lane) door area with fencing where there is none now. I have enlisted the help of Mr. Mark Peone, the architect of the great doors and front plaza to help design something beautiful. The security booth at the top of the parking lot close to Rosary Academy will be moved close to the east parking lot entrance gate. The grant is \$245,000, I think you would agree it is best that we accept it. But for this gift we would have to raise that amount of capital among ourselves.

Again, with help from the Diocese of Orange, we have applied to the Shea Family Foundation for a grant to resurface all asphalt areas – the teacher's lot on Acacia Avenue, the school lunch area, and the big parking lot. The grant also asks for funding to replace the gym floor. The surface is wearing poorly and there is a water problem with the cement floor under the top surface. The St. Juliana School's 2026 Gala fund-a-need will be to help pay for those projects. The school's Gala is January 30, 2026. We await the reply for the Shea Family Foundation grant. I want you to know that we are doing our best to look for free grant money before we raise and spend our own capital.

Finally, two community and faith formation events coming up real soon. Next Saturday we are celebrating the 60th Anniversary of our parish and grammar school. Mass will be celebrated at 5:00PM and a dinner catered by the Anaheim White House will be served in the parish center for \$60.00. The eighth graders and their parents will be especially honored. Please respond to the invitation sent to you...come and enjoy the community's celebration. It's just better when we are together.

On Sunday, December 7, a wonderfully joyful priest, Msgr. David Cassato, from Brooklyn will celebrate the 11:00 Mass, following that Mass there will be a catered lunch in the parish center and a talk on the "Joy of the Incarnation." Msgr. Cassato is enlightening, engaging, entertaining, and just plain inspiring. Not to mention, that Brooklyn accent and he is Italian! Please plan on being part of the celebrations of St. Juliana anniversary and beginning of Advent. It's better when we are together.

I've always closed by thanking you – you are a good and generous parish, you are appreciated, you are prayed for. God bless you, each one.

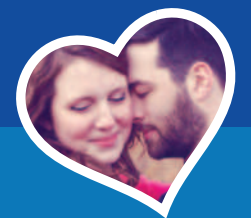
