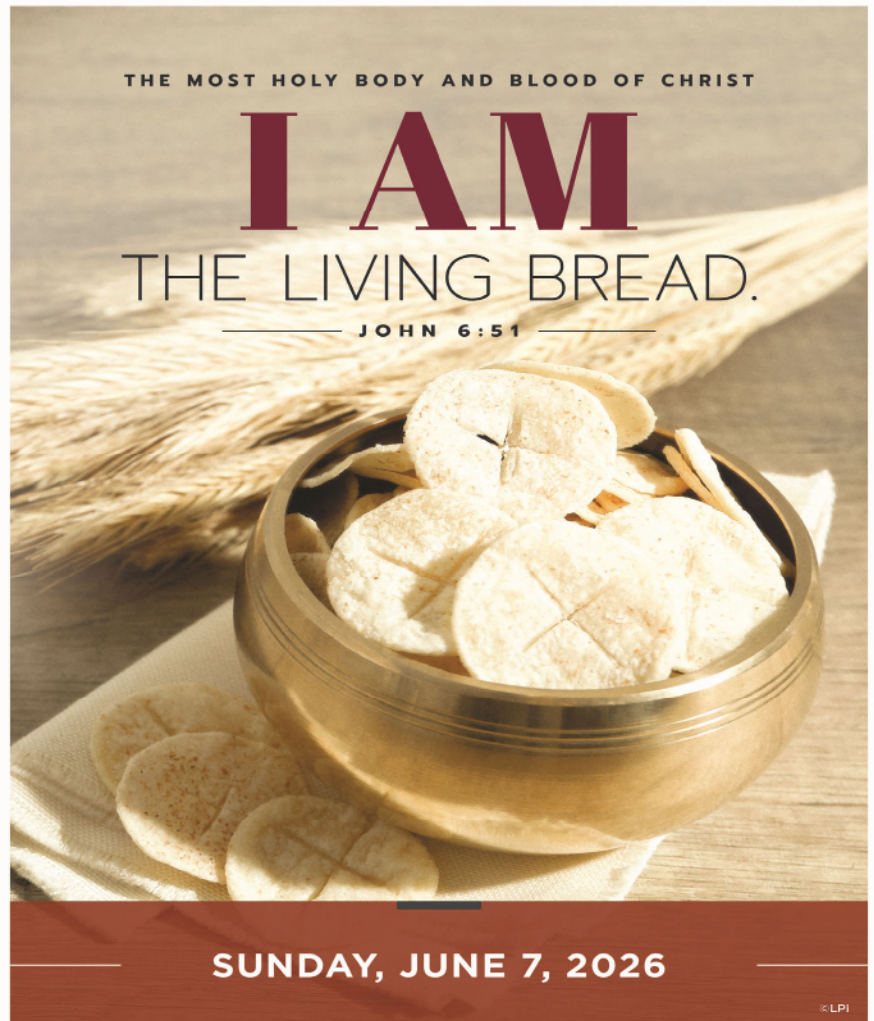

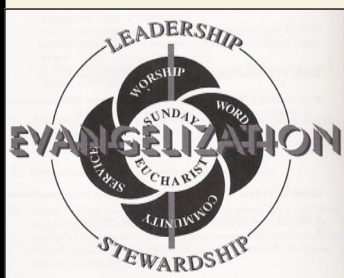
The vision of St. Juliana Falconieri Catholic Community is to live as a people of God with Christ at the center of our lives through liturgy, faith formation and community.

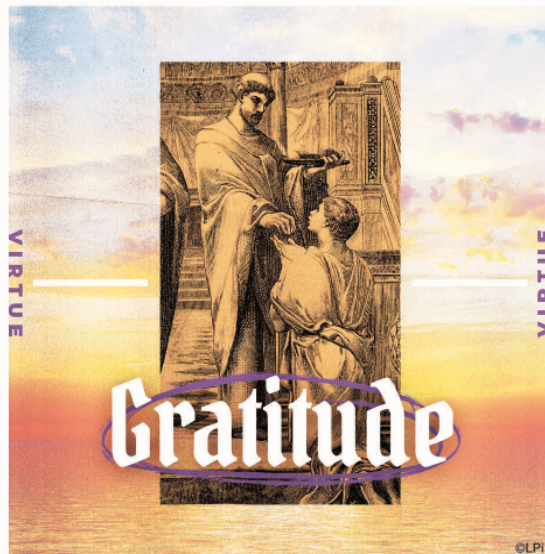

St. Vincent de Paul Essay

Jesus taught us to love our neighbors. The Lord said to his disciples, "you must love your neighbor as yourself." Loving your neighbor isn't just loving the people who live near you, it's respecting all of God's creation. The whole world deserves respect, not just those who live nearby. A couple ways you can follow God's law to "love thy neighbor as yourself," are talking respectfully and by showing kindness through your actions. Following this teaching is important because it strengthens your relationship with God. Because of this, even though it may be hard at times, you must follow Jesus' teaching to 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'

One way you can love your neighbor is through respectful talking. Talking respectfully is extremely important to following this teaching. For example, saying rude and unkind things is a violation of this teaching. One example of following this teaching is saying kind words and motivating those who are saddened. Saying kind things, just like acting respectfully, strengthens your relationship with God by following his teachings. By following Jesus' teaching to love your neighbor, you become a better person.

Like speaking with kindness, acting with love in your mind is an important way to follow Jesus' teachings. One example of acting with compassion is volunteering to help those less fortunate than yourself. The people you help would be extremely grateful for the help you provide. Following this matters because if you don't use compassionate actions, God will know, and He will be disappointed. A second example of kind actions is not hurting others. For example, if somebody says something rude or does something unkind, you shouldn't do it back. Instead of using your actions to hurt others, you could use your actions to help them. A way to follow this is if somebody drops something, maybe you could spend a few seconds to pick it up for them, just to show you care. Doing these things follows Jesus' teaching of loving your neighbor because your actions can show people you care about them.

One major rule to help to love your neighbor is to follow the golden rule. This states that you should only do things that you want done to you. The teaching to love your neighbor is important because kindness strengthens your relationship with God, and if you're rude to others, people won't appreciate it. I'm sure that when I follow Jesus' teaching to "love our neighbor as yourself," and show kindness, I reflect God's love and salvation to others.

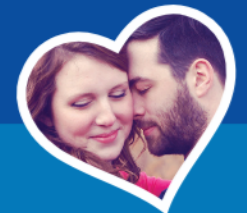
